

The columbarium is a sacred space and as such should be treated reverently. Please respect others while visiting by complying with the below guidelines.

The following activities are prohibited:

- Any form of sports or recreation, to include, but not limited to jogging, skating, bicycling, and picnicking.
- Public gatherings of a partisan nature.
- Littering of any kind.
- Cutting, breaking, or injuring trees, shrubs, or plantings.
- Climbing on or marring the surface of sacred art or statues.
- Pets are not allowed in columbarium.
- Boisterous actions.
- Unattended children under the age of 15.

Floral Regulations

- Flowers may be placed in columbarium throughout the year. They will be removed every Friday or sooner if they become unsightly. This includes artificial and potted flowers.
- Plantings are not permitted at any time
- Flowers may be placed directly on ground or in a temporary container.
- Statues, vigil lights, breakable objects, candles, and similar commemorative items are not permitted at any time.
- Floral items or any other decorations may not be secured or adhered to niche covers or walls.
- All items become Seton property and will be disposed of accordingly. Please be aware Seton is not responsible for maintaining, replacing and/or safeguarding items left in the columbarium.
