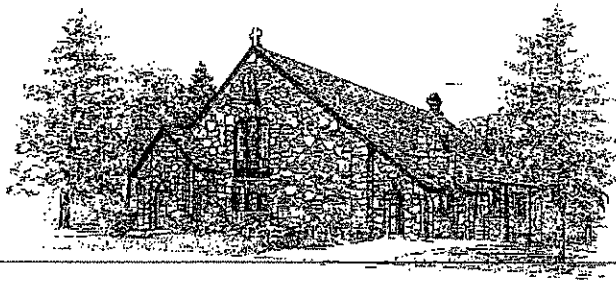

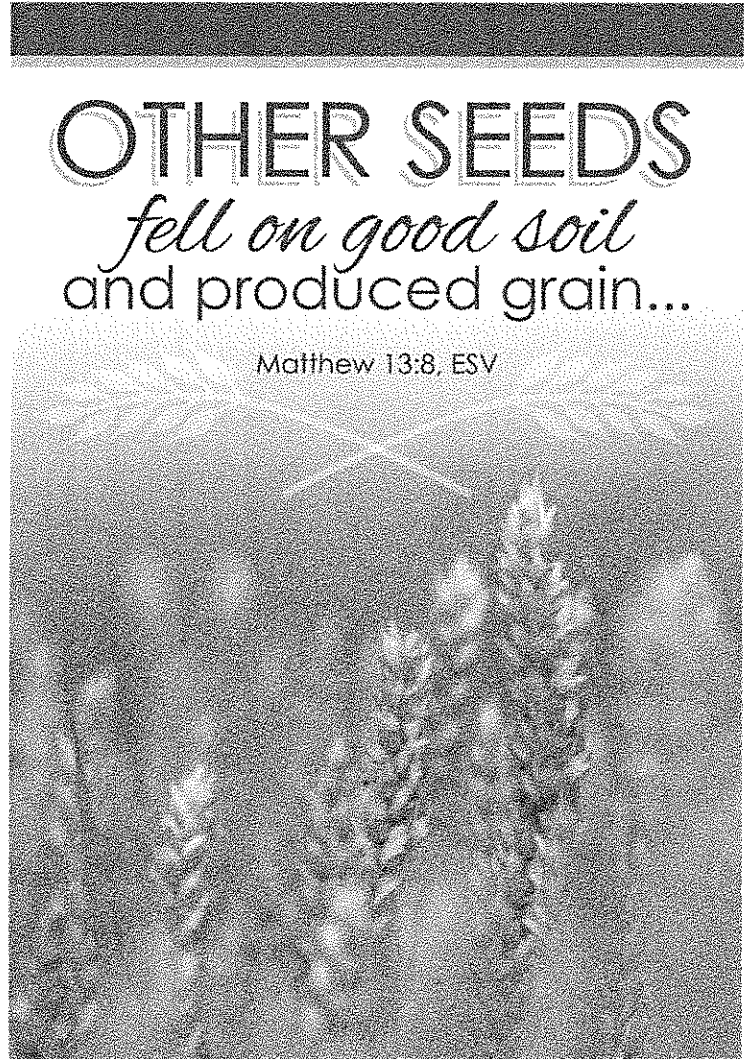

MONTHLY ASSESSMENT

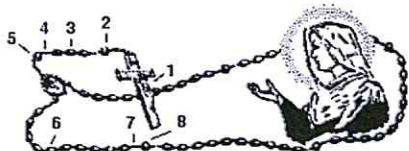
