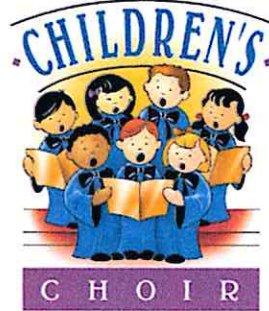
## ELLEN WHITE SCHOLARSHIP
