

Frequently, children cannot receive the sacraments of initiation, and Mass cannot be held regularly. missionaries Without catechists, the people living there cannot learn about, experience and share the beauty of our Catholic way of life. Your support to the Collection for the Church in Latin America has helped train lay people to become Catholic missionaries and catechists in parishes. With your help, people are being trained to bring the love and tenderness of God to these remote areas and have shown people living in Peru the mercy of Christ. The second "second" collection is the Catholic Home Mission Appeal. Home mission dioceses are those dioceses in the United States and its territories and former territories that cannot provide basic pastoral services without outside help. Basic pastoral services include Mass and the sacraments, religious education, and ministry training for priests, deacons, religious sisters, and lay people. Right now, over 40 percent of dioceses are considered home missions. Both collections will be taken up as the second collection on the weekend of May 20th.
