LAKE AREA FREE CLINIC

At any time in a person's life, they can find themselves in need of help. The Lake Area Free Clinic (LAFC) opened its doors in 2001. Our mission is to provide high-quality free medical services to those who are uninsured and unable to pay.

Did you know? Currently there are 23,000 uninsured adults in Waukesha County.

One of them could be you, your neighbor, friend or relative. Please help us to spread the word that the Clinic is here for them.

Eligibility at LAFC:

Resident of Waukesha County, or the rural areas of Jefferson and Dodge counties included in the Oconomowoc Area School District,
No health insurance

Household income meeting 250% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines.

As a medical home, services provided at the clinic include: acute and chronic care, laboratory tests, imaging, diabetic testing supplies, medications, access to ultrasound and echocardiogram. A number of specialty care services are offered as well as a comprehensive diabetes clinic. A referral network of specialists is available, when necessary, at no charge to eligible patients.

The Lake area Free Clinic receives no United Way or government funding. We rely on fund raising, grants and donations. For more information contact Megan Welsh at megan@lakeareafreeclinic.org.
