



Pope Pius IX entrusted the long-lost original ancient icon of Our Mother of Perpetual to the

For two weeks, the Redemptorist Retreat Center will display a traveling icon of Our Mother of Perpetual Help and invites the faithful to veneration and prayer in the newly constructed Shrine Chapelon the grounds of the property. The traveling icon is visiting all of the Redemptorist communities of the Denver Province. Last year it was commissioned in Rome and touched to the original icon in the Church of St. Alphonsus in Rome. CATHOLIC TRADITIONS EXPLAINED

Question: I really want to be more of a witness to faith, but am afraid of looking like a religious nut. How can I be more of a witness without becoming fanatical?

Answer Making bread is not difficult, but it does require that you blend water, flour, yeast, and salt in the right proportions or else the bread fails. Jesus uses the image of bread often when he speaks about spiritual things. Our life of faith requires balance, or the right blend of things, in order to be authentic and credible. Emotion, intellect, understanding, and spiritual practice are all essential to the life of a believer. When any of these elements are overemphasized to the detriment of the others, we risk the loss of balance and direction that leads us to "monotone, monochrome" thinking. We can give witness to our faith in small ways: a meal prayer even in a restaurant, a sign of the cross when passing a cemetery, a religious statue in our garden, an appropriate bumper sticker. Our witness to faith needs to be like yeast in bread-present, effective, transforming. When it guides your everyday life, when you stand up for what is right and good, when others see the person you are because of faith, your give great witness. The best sermon is often the one without any words, and others also see it in us. You might call it holiness. But be confident-there's a little bit of God in all of us!
