

### LIVE THE LITURGY - INSPIRATION FOR THE WEEK

Are we willing to be taught by God? If we are, then we will begin to see things and make judgments using a Divine lens. Often, we perceive things with purely human eyes and reference points. When we do this, reality can lose its Divine spark and we



miss what God is trying to say. When using human eyes exclusively, Jesus is at best perceived simply as a prophet who has some wise things to say. The human element has a difficult time seeing Jesus' divinity and recognizing him as the Bread of Life that comes down from heaven. We can easily get stuck on Jesus' human associations and overlook the marvelous wonders God wants us to see. If we really allow ourselves to be taught by God, we will then come to see the truth about Jesus and the abundant everlasting life God offers. Jesus becomes the key that unlocks all of our relationships: with God, others, ourselves, and creation. He, as the true and lasting bread from heaven, shows us the gifts of faith, hope, and love that God bestows on us. ### Fun Facts for Catholic Kids of ALL Ages



Have you ever felt like you wanted to run away from a situation?

Over the past two weeks we have heard how God feeds his people and takes care of their needs. Today we hear the story about the

prophet Elijah, who lay weak with hunger feeling totally hopeless, until God saved him. *Kings* 19:1-8

Why did Elijah feel so fed up? He had argued with King Ahab and upset him, and he believed that the king might have him killed. Elijah's life was in danger, so he set off into the wilderness where no one could find him. He left in a panic to escape from the King's soldiers. He wasn't prepared for such a journey through the desert, and he carried little food or water. It didn't take long for him to feel hungry, thirsty, and very tired. How do you feel when you're hungry, thirsty, and tired? I know that I feel pretty miserable when I'm tired and need something to eat. Some people call that feeling "hangry" (hungry and angry). If you go too long without food your body starts to lack the energy needed to carry on.

What made Elijah feel better and lift his spirits? God saw that Elijah needed something to eat and drink. He knew that after a nourishing meal Elijah would feel much better and would be able to carry on. God sees when WE are in trouble or great need, and always sends his spirit to help us and to give us strength.

In the Holy Eucharist, Jesus gives us the gift of himself, the Bread of Life. In this way, he becomes a part of us and helps us to become one with him.

Have you ever felt like you wanted to run away from a situation? Can you imagine setting off on a trip without packing food or water? As a family, talk about the times you have felt really hungry. Talk about a time when God provided something you needed. Ask God to feed and take care of your family's needs.


