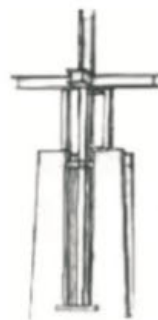

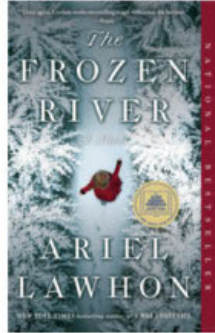

St. Bruno Mission Statement

St. Bruno Parish is a community of people sharing a common faith in the teachings of the Catholic tradition. We come together to worship God and to spread the Good News that Jesus gave us. Through celebrating Christian unity, we provide emotional support and practice the works of mercy.

St. Bruno's Circle of Life Ministry will be facilitating an eight-week Bereavement Support Group, beginning on Tuesday, June 3rd. Anyone who has lost a loved one recently, or even some time ago, is invited to participate. The presentations are taken from Alan Wolfelt's book, *Understanding Your Grief: Ten essential Touchstones for Finding Hope and Healing Your Heart*. 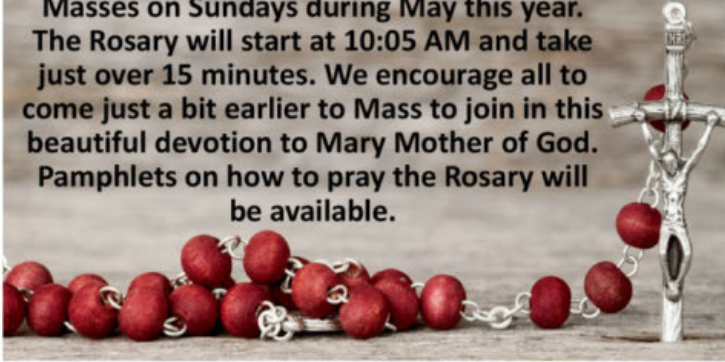
