St. Bruno Parish is a community of people sharing a common faith in the teachings of the Catholic tradition. We come together to worship God and to spread the Good News that Jesus gave us. Through celebrating Christian unity, we provide emotional support and practice the works of mercy.

Prayer Before Meals, Explained

Anyone who has ever dined in a Catholic home has probably heard the prayer before meals that begins with the famous words: "Bless us, O Lord, and these thy gifts." These words in particular are first found in the Galesian Sacramentary, a book of Christian liturgy that dates to the seventh or eighth century, but the practice of praying before meals is Biblical, harkening back to the Jewish ritual washing of hands before eating. In the Gospels, Jesus is shown praying before the Last Supper and other meals, setting an example followed by Paul in Acts 27:35.

In his 2015 encyclical Laudato SI', Pope Francis urged the faithful "to return to this beautiful and meaningful custom."

"That moment of blessing," he wrote, "reminds us of our dependence on God for life; it strengthens our feeling of gratitude for the gifts of creation...(and) reaffirms our solidarity with those in greatest need." ©LPi

Pilgrims

"We are pilgrims on a journey. We are trav'lers on the road; we are here to help each other walk the mile and bear the load." Many of us have sung these lyrics from "The Servant Song" by Richard Gillard, but do we really think of ourselves as pilgrims? Do we craft our lives with our final destination in mind, or are we tempted to give undue weight to the temporary goals and baggage of life? After all, what does it really mean to be a pilgrim?

In a religious context, a pilgrim is simply a person who makes a journey to a sacred place. We, indeed, are a pilgrim people travelling through this life to our heavenly home. Yet most of us could benefit from smaller pilgrimages along the way to guide our spiritual growth and strengthen our faith. In fact, making a pilgrimage is a long cherished tradition of the Catholic Church. A pilgrimage offers the opportunity to step away from the cares and stress of daily life and live in the moment. The journey may be long, such as travelling to the Holy Land or walking the Camino de Santiago, or it may be as short as visiting a nearby shrine. The idea is that the physical journey accompanies and amplifies the interior journey of the spirit. These sacred journeys can bring clarity to our minds, hearts, and souls not merely by reaching the destination, but rather through the process of seeking our God along the path.

During this 2025 Jubilee Year of Hope, the Archdiocese of Milwaukee has designated local sites as places of pilgrimage. Watch for information about PILGRIMS, an opportunity for the St. Bruno and St. Paul parish families to make pilgrimages to these sites together! Dates and details coming soon.


