





Summer Scams


Summertime is a lot of fun, but scammers prey on this busy time of year hoping we will be distracted enough to fall for their lies.

If you receive an email claiming to be from Father Dan or Parish Staff, ask yourself:

Were you expecting to hear from the person emailing you? Does the email ask for financial information, gift cards, or money? Is the email coming from an email address that you do not recognize and that is not published in the bulletin or website directory? Is the grammer or the spelling in the email incorrect or "off"?

Did you answer "yes" to any of these questions? If so, the email is not from us! Do not click any links, report the email as "phishing" and delete it from your inbox and trash.


