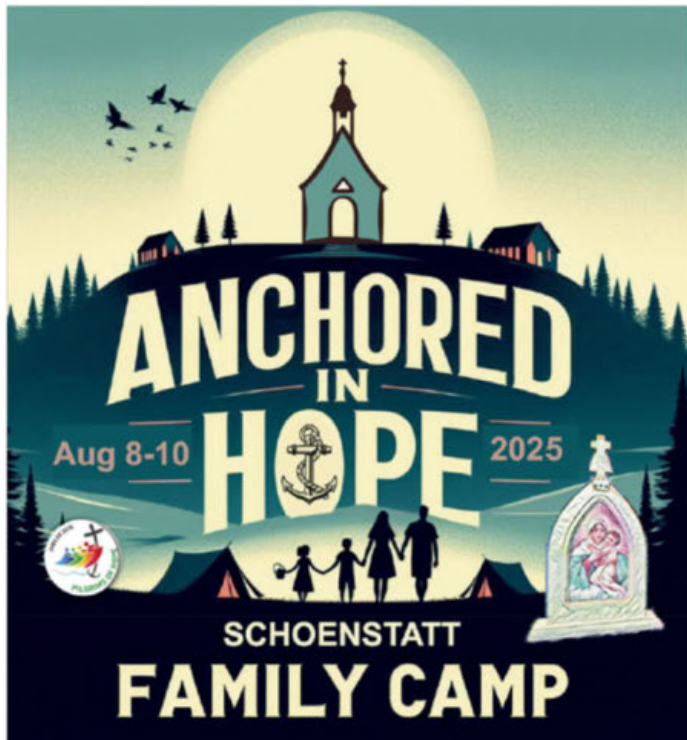

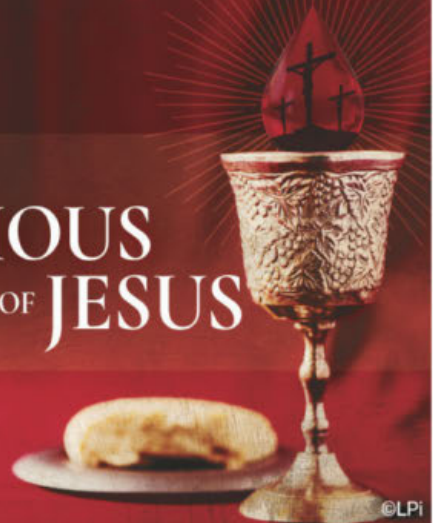

We are appealing for East African Mission Sisters of the Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament (SABS) in East Africa.

Our first SABS Missionaries stepped into East African Mission in Kenya in 1994 and at present we are 105 Sisters in Africa. We have established our communities in 4 countries- Kenya – 10, Tanzania – 9, Uganda – 3 and Rwanda- 1, in East Africa, 1 in Germany and 1 in America. Mostly we work in the rural villages among the poor and needy.

We have 4 adoration centers in East Africa: Provincial house in Otiende, Nairobi, Novitiate house in Kimumu, Eldoret (Kenya) and St. John Paul II Adoration convent Nala (Tanzania) and St. Charles Lwanga Adoration convent, Lugazi (Uganda) respectively.
