

Please join us in congratulating Lisa on this incredible achievement and in thanking her for sharing her gifts and passion with our school community!



Sisters in Africa. We have established our communities in 4countries- Kenya – 10, Tanzania – 9, Uganda – 3 and Rwanda- 1, in East Africa, 1 in Germany and 1 in America. Mostly we work in the rural villages among the poor and needy.
