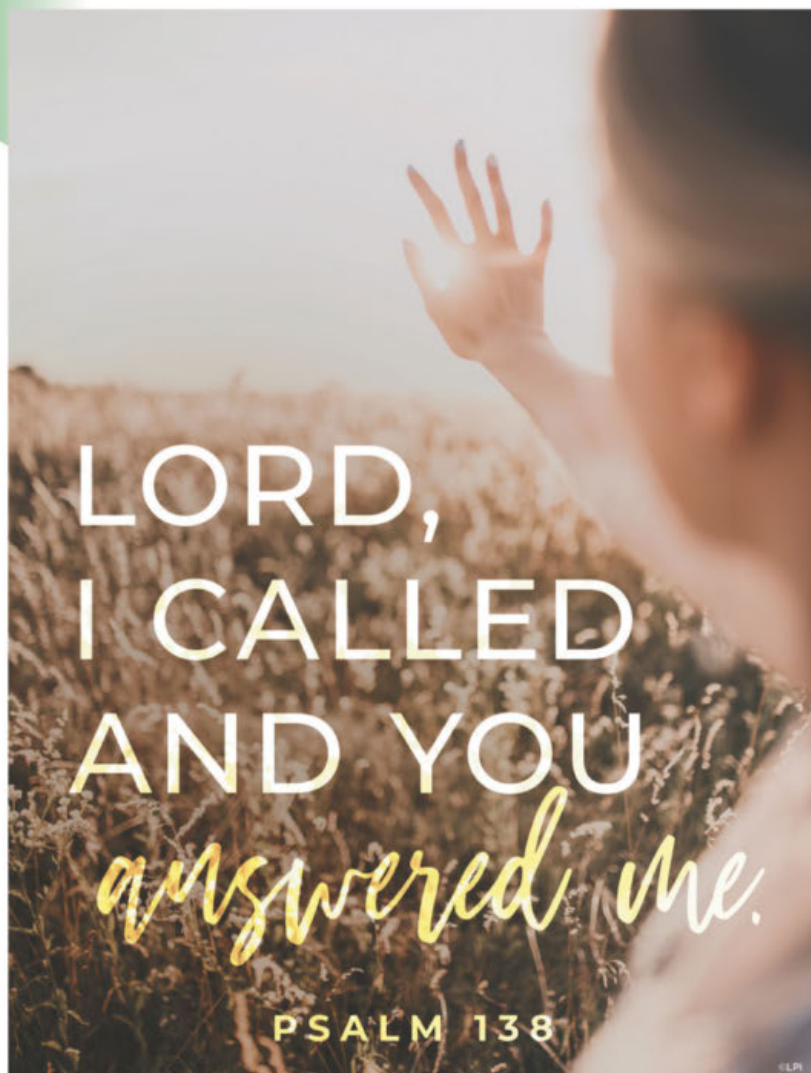
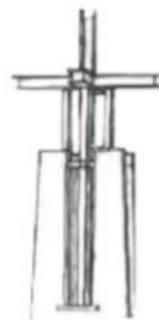

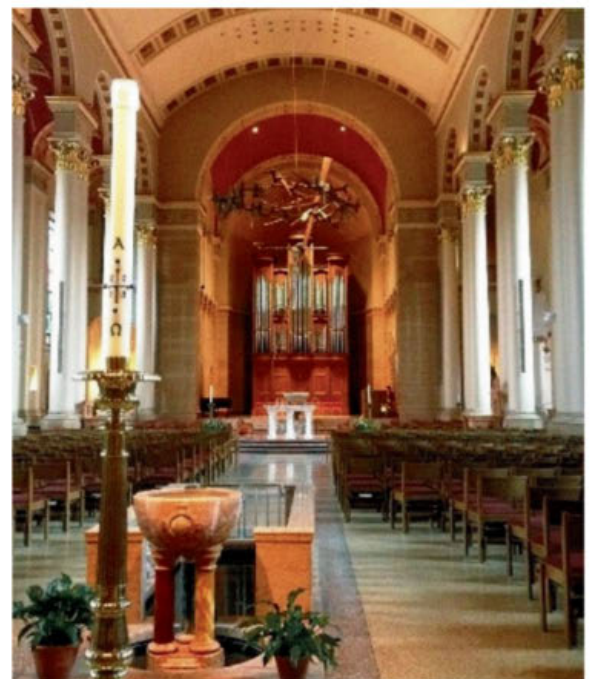

#### Exciting news:

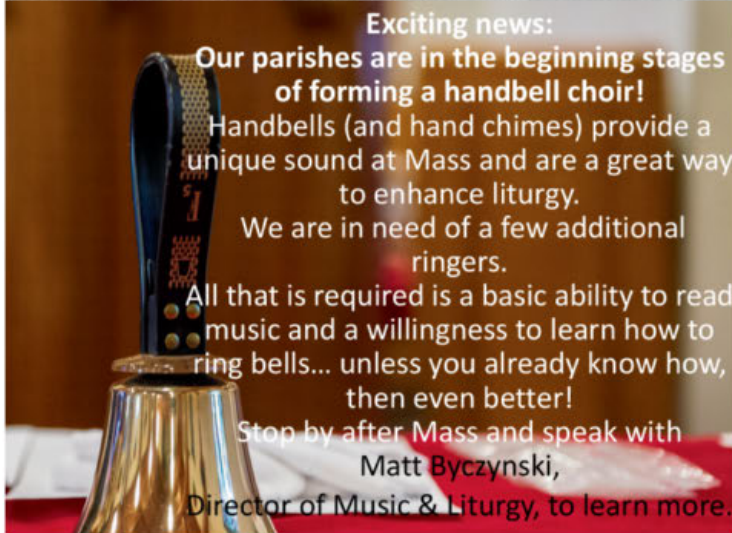
Our parishes are in the beginning stages of forming a handbell choir!

Stop by after Mass and speak with Matt Byczynski, Director of Music & Liturgy, to learn more.



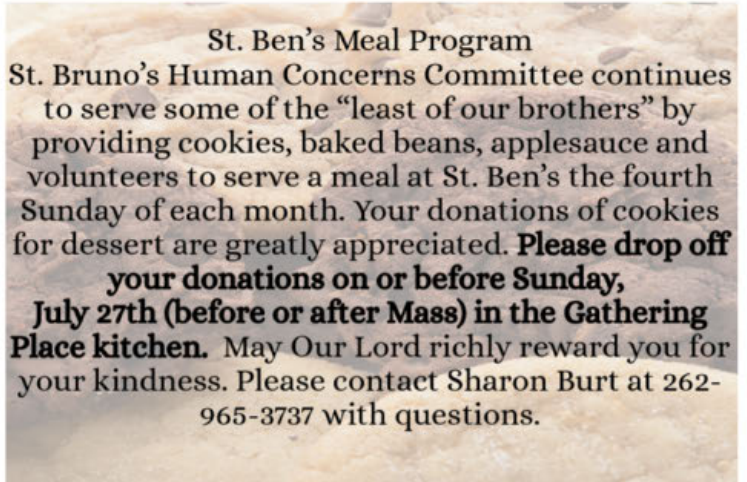
#### **Children's Liturgy of the Word**

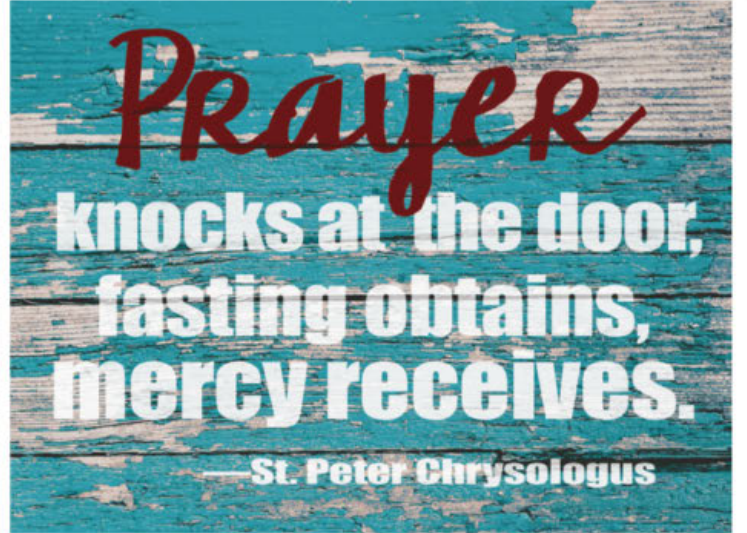
#### **St. Ben's Meal Program**

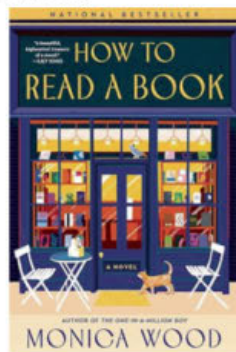

Did you answer "yes" to any of these questions? If so, the email is not from us! Do not click any links, report the email as "phishing" and delete it from your inbox and trash.
