

St. Bruno Mission Statement



What is OCIA?

OCIA stands for the Order of Christian Initiation of Adults. It is a process whereby adults may learn about the faith and prepare to join the Catholic Church. Until recently, this process was called RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults). Who is the OCIA process for? It is for anyone who wants to become Catholic as well as for those who did not complete the sacraments of initiation in the Catholic Church. OCIA formation includes those who:

- · have never been baptized.
- · have been validly baptized but are not Catholic.
- have been baptized but never received First Communion and/or Confirmation.






