



## Opportunities to BELIEVE

### Adult Faith Formation Director: Nancy Boerger

#### Come to the Table (Part 4)

Around the world at every celebration of the Mass, Catholics enter into a Eucharistic ritual that both recalls Christ's once-for-all sacrifice and makes it present to us in our own time. When Jesus commanded, "Do this in memory of me," he was not asking the apostles to hold gatherings in his honor to remember his salvific deeds. Rather, he was teaching them how to offer worship under the new covenant. To be true worship, these memorial dinners must include a sacrifice. This is a concept that all Jewish people understood well. Worship in the Temple was built around sacrifices. The Passover memorial, so foundational to Jewish life, involved the sacrifice of an unblemished lamb. At Passover, the people commemorated their exodus from Egypt, but in a true sense also participated in it as a present reality. This tradition was carried forward to the Last Supper - the final Passover meal shared by Jesus and the apostles. Jesus' words "in memory" come from the Greek word anamnesis, which has its roots in the Old Testament memorial offerings. In anamnesis, the act of remembering is transformed into something dynamic, a living re-presentation of a memorial sacrifice. Through the liturgy of the Eucharist, we take part in this dynamic encounter with God, and because God is outside of space and time, we are brought into communion with the faithful at every Mass throughout the world.




