Liturgical Ministry

- Altar servers – All the 4th graders have just been trained & they have been cycling through the weekday Masses with the hope that they will begin weekends in the summer. Mark will talk with Amy about RE servers.
- Ushers
 - Need ushers - Sue will do a write-up for bulletin. Will later schedule AED training.
 - Ushers should keep the doors to the inside of the church closed until Mass begins to sustain a peaceful environment for the people who are praying.
- Readers – Need to begin the Minister prayer 10 minutes before Mass. Louise will talk to the lectors.
- General – Need lay ministers there 15 minutes before Mass for sign up/prayer. If they are not present, the sacristan may find a substitute - Mark will submit to Jan.

Easter (review)

- **Palm Sunday** – new procession order went well; readers were happy to not wear albs; worked well to have the choir read the “crowd”. (4pm Mass – a few people were asked if they would read the “crowd” portion when they entered Mass)
 - Future: If Extraordinary ministers aren’t doing the procession as usual, we need to let them know. Begin Liturgical Movement planning of January next year in hopes of getting volunteers (either teen or adult).
- **Holy Thursday** – Was a beautiful Mass and everyone liked the procession past the Tabernacle. People stayed until midnight.
 - Future: Additional chairs in the gathering place near the tabernacle and remind the Eucharistic Ministers to remain for clean up after Mass.
- **Good Friday** – Was a nice service and the use of a different cross was fine. Attendance seemed to be about the same. The big cross was very nice in the Gathering Place.
- **Holy Saturday** - We will have the Easter Vigil next year.
- **Easter Sunday** - At least 40 people came for a 10:30 AM Mass which was not held due to time changes although the Mass times were posted for two months
 - Future: make sure that the Senior Living facilities with the right times
