# St. Bruno 3K/4K Frequently Asked Questions

### • How do I enroll in St. Bruno's 3K/4K program?

Space is limited! We want to keep our class size at a minimum to allow for as much attention as possible with our students. Call the school office for enrollment forms (262-965-2291) or visit our website (www.stbrunoparishschool.com).

### What will the 3/4-year-old kindergarten program look like at St. Bruno?

St. Bruno 3K/4K is not a day care. We are offering 5 full days a week to our families. 3K/4K will blend four areas of child development: head, hands, heart, and soul. Age-appropriate academics will be infused in play-based learning experiences in a faith-centered environment. Full-day students will get a rich schooling experience with lunch, recess, and even gym class! There will also be a rest time built into the day to allow for students to relax and reenergize their minds and bodies.

### Does my child need to be potty trained?

Yes. Pull-ups are not considered potty trained. They also need to be completely independent with restroom usage (i.e.: getting up on the toilet, wiping, hand washing, etc.).

### • Is there before or after-school care available?

St. Bruno offers before care starting at 7:30 am, and after care runs after the regular school day from 3:30-6:00pm which has alternative pricing outside of tuition. If students would need to be here all day, they would need to enroll in our full day option.

## How was the tuition determined for 3K?

Tuition for our full day 3-year-old program is the same as the half-day option for 4K. Pricing will remain the same if parents opt to not send their child for the full day. Investing in 3K will set children up for a successful learning experience in the rest of their schooling career. With no taxpayer funding like a public school, our program needs to be self-sustaining through tuition so that we are able to offer this wonderful opportunity to our community. With the costs associated with traditional daycare, our tuition is very reasonable for the quality learning experience that we have to offer.

## • Will 5-days a week be too much for my child?

Many of our St. Bruno families are a dual-working household and have a need for an all-day schooling option for their children. Students that attend a full school week have consistency and routines without "starting" over with days in between. We can meet with individual families and develop a transition plan for your child if you think 5 days a week may be too much to start.

### My child is almost 3 years old, can I enroll in 3K?

Children need to be 3 or 4 years old on or before September 1.

## Does my child need a uniform in 3K?

Uniforms are optional in 3K and 4K.

## Would my child be able to take the bus to school?

Unfortunately, 3-year-olds are not able to take the bus to or from school, even if they have an older sibling that is able to ride.

### • We are not Catholic; can my child still attend your school?

Yes! St. Bruno educates and welcomes children of all faiths! Faith formation in our 3K will focus on age-appropriate Christian values and common Bible stories. Students will be attending weekly Mass.

#### • When can we check out the school?

We always host an open house/meet and greet before school starts so students can meet their teacher and drop off school supplies. You can also call to schedule a tour at any time.
