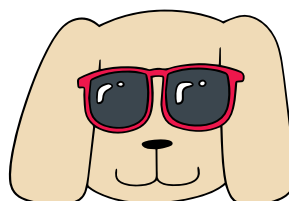
All ladies are invited! Bring your daughter, mother or friend!
