## Feast of the Most Holy Trinity

Each year on the first Sunday after Pentecost we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity, also known as Trinity Sunday. Although it wasn't until 1334 that Pope John XXII officially established the feast for universal observance in the Western Church, the mystery of the Holy Trinity has been the pulse of the Church's life since the very beginning. The Trinity is "the central mystery of Christian faith and life...[and is] the source of all the other mysteries of faith" (CCC 234) (source: Catholic Apostolic Center)

**A. Please call the parish office or you can go [here](#) to download a virtual packet. You can also get one before or after Mass in the Gathering Place from a volunteer.**



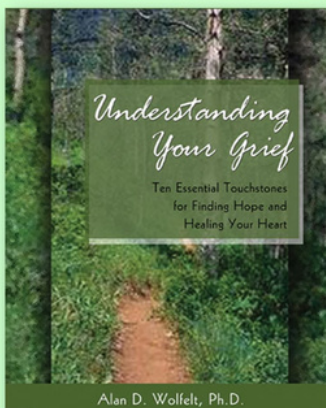

1. Open to the presence of your loss
2. Dispel misconceptions about grief
3. Embrace the uniqueness of your grief
4. Explore what you might experience
5. Recognize you are not crazy
6. Understand the six needs of mourning
7. Nurture yourself
8. Reach out for help
9. Seek reconciliation, not resolution
10. Appreciate your transformation

Author, educator, and grief counselor, Dr. Alan Wolfelt is known across North America for his inspirational teaching. Dr. Wolfelt uses a "companioning" model of bereavement which emphasizes a nurturing, soul-based nature of the grief journey.
