Speech, Hearing, and Vision Screening Information 2025-2026 school year

St. Bruno Parish School will be screening students for speech, hearing, and vision this school year at no cost during the regular school day. Screenings ensure that all of our students have the best chance to succeed at school. You will be informed of the results of any screening and next steps to take, if any. A copy of all results will be added to your child's school file. If you **do not** want your child to participate, please complete, sign and date the Speech, Hearing, and Vision Screening Opt Out Form and return to school by August 29, 2025. Why is it important to have your student's speech, hearing, and/or vision screened?

- Speech, vision, and hearing impact your child's ability to learn.
- Speech, vision, and hearing screenings can help identify concerns and possible delays early.
- Hearing loss is invisible, and your student may appear to be not paying attention.
- Eye problems can be asymptomatic.

This is the screening schedule by grade level:

3K, 4K, 5K - speech, hearing, vision 1, 2, 3, 7 - hearing, vision 4, 5, 6, 8 - vision

Speech screenings will be conducted by our speech-language pathologist Mrs. Jann Fujimoto. This screening takes about 10-15 minutes. Your child will look at pictures and answer questions. If a student is already receiving speech therapy services through Kettle Moraine School District, their local public school district, or St. Bruno Parish School, then they will not be screened for speech.

Hearing screenings will be conducted by Marquette University graduate and/or undergraduate students studying Communication Disorders under the supervision of our speech-language pathologist Mrs. Jann Fujimoto. They are trained on the audiometers as part of their academic coursework. Your child will wear earphones and raise their hands when a sound is heard. This screening takes about 5-10 minutes. If your child has a hearing aid and/or a cochlear implant, then they will not be screened for hearing.

Vision screenings will be conducted by southeast Wisconsin Lions Club volunteers who have been trained on the vision screening equipment. Your child will be seated approximately three feet from the vision screener, who will train a machine on the child's eyes. This takes less than 5 minutes. Students in all grades will be screened, even if they wear glasses or contacts.
