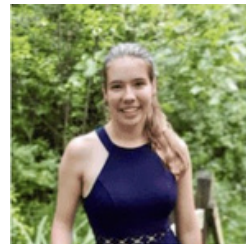
2. Make a Difference: As a member, you'll be able to serve in meaningful ways, contributing your unique gifts and talents to our parish and community.
