Guest Speaker: Bill Wynne

- Bill was one of the facilitators of the Anti-Racism Program that ran for 7 consecutive Wednesdays from October 2 November 13 at Church of the Assumption and at Church of the Resurrection.
- Reference materials had been e-mailed to PPC members prior to the December 11 meeting.
- Bill presented highlights and feedback from the program including attendance, demographics of attendees, results of participation surveys, facilitator assessments, and priority action steps.
- Closing thoughts from the facilitators is that this is a start in our efforts and reflections and should
 not be considered that one Anti-Racism program is enough to overcome a long history of racism that
 is still present today. The recommendations of the facilitators, therefore, are being presented for
 reflection and actions to the PPC.

Pastor's Report:

- Father George reported on parish trends in eastern Monroe County. All parishes in this area reported drops in overall attendance, decreases in offerings, median income increases, and an increase of households when October 2018 was compared to October 2019.
- Question What does the future look like in 5 years? Proactively, how do we not give up on evangelization?
- Suggestion There is a need to look at increased giving campaign options starting during Lent.
- "Our Sunday Visitor" This is an increased giving company that has been used by St. John of Rochester successfully twice. Other companies will also be contacted and spoken with.
