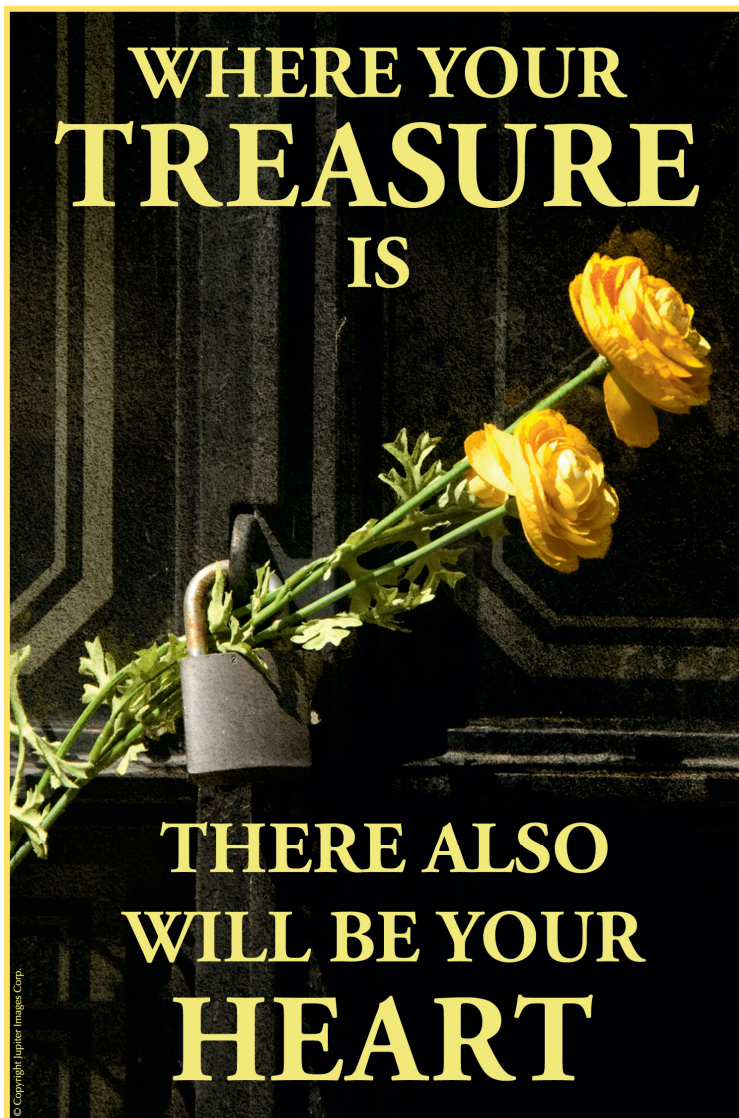

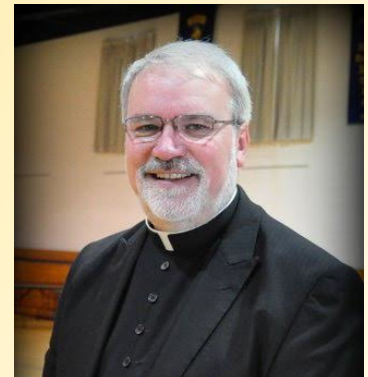

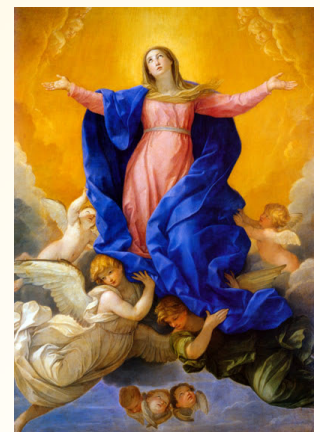
From the Pastor's Desk...

It's hard to believe that school will be starting for many of our area students in a little more than a week. I say it every year at this time, "Where did the summer go?" Hopefully, these past couple of months were a time for some rest, relaxation, reflection, and renewal for us all.



Many thanks to those in the parish that took the time to read my bulletin article last weekend and to assure me that the new Mass schedule will be fine once we all adjust to it. As one parishioner put it, "Changing patterns of worship requires changes in response to them but might also be a new opportunity in disguise". I would like all in the parish to know that the decision to modify our Sunday Mass schedule this fall was made after careful and thoughtful consideration as well as the result of declining attendance and reduction in clergy. No one likes change (including me) but we needed to realistically respond to the situation and circumstances before us. I don't think anyone in the parish would disagree with the assessment of what we see each and every weekend with regard to lower attendance. As we look to our future we will need to be more consciously aware of our lay and clergy resources. More information on this topic will follow in the weeks ahead.

This Thursday, August 15th, is the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary. This day is considered a Holy Day of Obligation. For this reason, we will be celebrating three Masses on Thursday, August 15th. The morning Masses will be at 6:30 a.m. and 9:00 a.m. We will also provide an opportunity for those who are working during the day to attend an evening Mass at 7:00 p.m. on Thursday night. (Please note that there will not be an evening Mass of anticipation on Wednesday night). Please plan on joining us as we celebrate that special moment and occasion of Mary's Assumption into heaven, where she was joined for all eternity with her son, Jesus Christ in the place from which she awaits us still.

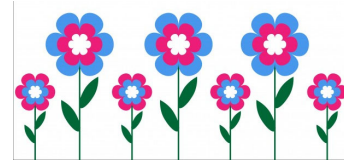

TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

When Pope Pius XII died in 1958, there was the usual buzz of speculation about likely successors. Cardinal Agagianian, Patriarch of the Armenians, was highly thought of as a likely choice. This took many Catholics by surprise, since he had never celebrated the same liturgy as Pope Pius, but followed ancient Armenian customs according to the Eastern Church, which veils the Eucharistic liturgy from sight by a series of curtains, and in which the priest kneels while the people stand for Communion.

In the years that followed, the Second Vatican Council would affirm the dignity and independence of the Eastern Churches, in complete union with Rome, yet different in patterns of life and worship. We have the same faith, the same sacraments, and the same pope. Yet everywhere in the world our separate Churches are combined into families held together by the ministry of bishops. All of this serves as warning: If you ever say, But we've always done it this way, you are on very thin ice indeed!

UPCOMING TRIPS & PILGRIMAGES WITH FR. RICH

It's been great to see that the parishioners of our parish have been accustomed to participating in travel opportunities with their parish priests over the years here at St. Eugene. For the past many years I have also led and coordinated trips and pilgrimages around the world with parishioners and their families and friends at the parishes where I have served. I see these trips as opportunities for us to get to know each other better in a more relaxed and casual environment, while at the same time seeing and experiencing some of the most fascinating and beautiful places on this planet.

Over the past few months, I have been laying out our next three years of travels based on the suggestions I have heard from those whom I have travelled with in the past. I have learned that what most people appreciate is the advance notice of upcoming trips so that they can plan their calendars as well as begin to save for them. So, here are the next trips that I have planned over the next three years that you are all invited to be a part of:

2020 Sicily and Rome (12 Days) October 18 – 29, 2020

Includes an audience with Pope Francis, classical tour of the Colosseum, Roman Forum, Capitoline & Palatine Hills, Vatican Museum, Sistine Chapel, St. Peter's Basilica, Montecassino, Pompeii, Sorrento & an Amalfi Coast excursion, Taormina, Piazza Armerina, Agrigento, Monreale, Palermo & visit to Erice (one of the oldest inhabited places on the whole island of Sicily and so much more that will be detailed in the brochure.



2021 The Holy Land and Jordan (13 Days) April 11 – 23, 2021

Includes Jerusalem, Garden of Gethsemane, Church of the Ascension, Church of the Pater Noster, the Upper Room, the Wailing Wall, the old city of Jerusalem, Via Dolorosa, Church of the Holy Sepulchre, Holocaust Museum (Yad Vashem), Mount of Olives, Bethlehem, Grotto of the Nativity, the Shepherd's Field, Sea of Galilee, Nazareth, Tiberias, Caesarea-by-the-Sea, Jericho, the Dead Sea, Masada, Qumran, Mount of Beatitudes, Jordan River, Masada, Mt. Cairo, the famous Egyptian Museum of Antiquities, Giza, the Sphinx, the Pyramids, Luxor, Karnak where the great Pharaohs of Egyptian history built their monuments, Valley of the Kings and Queens, Tomb of Tutankhamun, Temple of Queen Hatshepsut, the temple city of Amun-Re, Edfu, Nile River cruise, Aswan and its famous New High Aswan Dam, Kom Ombo, the Granite Quarries, Cairo's Coptic Quarter and the Coptic Museum, we will see the "Sound & Light" Show where the history of the pharaohs magically comes alive, Dahshur, Abusir, Saqqara, Memphis, the Open Air Museum and the Colossus of Ramsesses II, the step Pyramid of King Djoser, the Land of Goshen (a place in Egypt given to the Hebrews by the pharaoh), Lake Timsah (Reed Sea), Alexandria and the famous Lighthouse of Pharos (one of the seven wonders of the world), the National Museum of Alexandria. 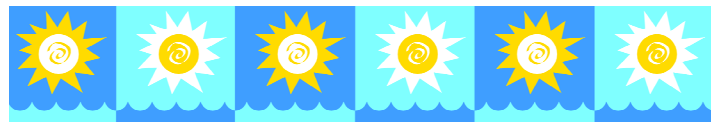

Grief Support Group at St. Paul of the Cross

The Grief Share program features biblical, Christ-centered teaching that focuses on grief topics associated with the death of a loved one. The DVD seminar features nationally respected grief experts and real-life stories of people, followed by a small group discussion about what was viewed.
