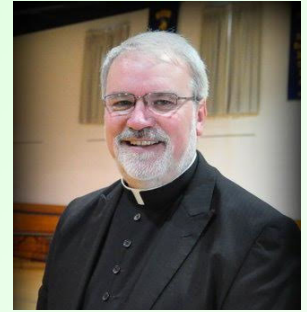

**A Fond Farewell,
Best wishes,
and sincere gratitude for your six years
among us here at St. Eugene**

From the Pastor's Desk...



Today, June 28th, we offer our farewell to Fr. Greg Wojcik who has served our parish community of St. Eugene for the past six years. It is a time of mixed emotion for us all. We are on the one hand saddened that he is departing from us but on the other hand we wish him all the best as he begins his six-month sabbatical. We can only hope and pray that our parish was able to strengthen the foundation upon which Fr. Greg's future priestly ministry continues to be built. Relationships that are formed in a priest's assignments can last their lifetime. May that be the case for Fr. Greg. He has certainly touched the lives of many here at St. Eugene. For this we are indeed grateful.

Normally, we would have had a farewell reception in the Shaunessy Center but, sadly, due to the COVID-19 reality and all the restrictions for the gathering of crowds, we had to forego that plan. Instead, today, Sunday, June 28th, from 12:00 noon until 3:00 pm., you have an opportunity to offer your farewell and thanks to Fr. Greg who will be standing near the canopy entrance of the church. and you will be able to pull up in your car to offer your best wishes or park your car and walk over to bid him farewell. We would ask that you enter/drive in from the west end of the church parking lot so that you can drive to the front of church and then exit onto Foster Ave.

He will also be celebrating the 9:30 Mass today, June 28th. So, you have two opportunities to say goodbye this weekend.

I know that I speak for us all here at St. Eugene in wishing Fr. Greg all the best as he begins this next journey in his life.

The Archdiocese of Chicago requires that anyone attending Sunday Mass must register in advance online. The privilege to reopen for Mass is offered with a limit to the maximum number of people who can be in our churches at one time. Currently that number is 15 – 20% of each church's capacity. For us here at St. Eugene that would be around 225 people. We began with a lesser number so that our volunteers and mass goers could ease into this new process. **We must maintain records for the Illinois Department of Public Health of all who enter our churches for contact tracing if and when a confirmed case of COVID-19 is identified. When we resume daily Mass, you will not be required to make a reservation, however, a volunteer will be there to take your information at church.**

Thanks to everyone who are slowly but surely returning to Mass. It was great to see so many of our parishioners again returning to Mass. Remember the requirement to attend Sunday Mass has been lifted and we still stream the 9:30 AM Mass live on our YouTube channel which you can access by going to our St. Eugene Website. **If you are not feeling well, are over 65 or compromised medically, we encourage you to participate by watching Mass on TV or online. We want everyone to be safe!** Hopefully, we are on the path to discovering what our “new-normal” will be. Though our experience of coming back to church is very different than what we were used to, it was still great to be back in our church again worshipping with one another. As you may have noticed, it took a little longer to get into your seat in church and it may not have necessarily been where you usually sat or wanted to be seated. There is a reason for this seating process, and it has everything to do with the necessity of cleaning and disinfecting the areas/sections where people sit after each Mass and Service. We seat people by section so that we do not make more work for our maintenance/cleaning crew than is necessary, especially if we didn’t need to use all the areas of our church. We ask that you assist us in this process by following the directions of our volunteers that will be directing you to your seats. You are also given the opportunity to disinfect your hands upon entering and requested to wear your own face mask. If you do not have one, one will be provided. Please try and follow the directions that will be given at Mass by either the trained volunteers or the celebrant of the Mass.

Everything has gone very smoothly over the past two weekends because of our dedicated staff and volunteers who helped with all the Masses.

Speaking of volunteers. We are in desperate need of 30 – 50 more volunteers to assist with upcoming weekend and, hopefully, soon-to-be-started daily masses, as well as some of our sacramental services down the line. What is keeping us from going back to the celebration of daily mass, confessions, adoration, etc. is our shortage of trained volunteers that need to be present at each of these celebrations. If we do not get more volunteers, we will burn out the few that have already graciously signed-up to help as they cannot be expected to be at every Mass and sacramental celebration every day and week. Please consider signing up by emailing Reopen@st-eugene.org and leaving a message that you are willing to help. You will then be responded to with the information to watch a one-hour training webinar and then will have a St. Eugene training session in our church. **WE NEED OUR PARISHIONERS TO SIGN-UP ASAP – ESPECIALLY OUR YOUNGER MEMBERS 18 AND OLDER.** If we do not get these volunteers, I fear we will have to cut back our weekend Mass schedule and limit the potential of resuming daily Mass and other sacramental celebrations. I would hate to see that happen, especially since we’ve gotten this far. Please go to Reopen@st-eugene.org and join our reopening effort. **WE NEED YOU!** Thanks so much.

I also want to sincerely thank those that have already generously signed up to volunteer and have viewed the Archdiocesan Training Webinar as well as been trained here at St. Eugene to assist with our Masses and sacramental services thus far. Your generosity of time has enabled us to open our church doors again. Thank you so much!

Finally, with Fr. Greg's departure, we are waiting to hear if we will be getting a new associate priest. Getting one will enable us to get back to a somewhat more normal schedule of Masses and services. If we do not, however, some adjustments and modifications to our former schedule of daily Masses and Services will need to be made. I will keep you posted as more information becomes available. This, too, is part of the new reality facing many of our parishes but there are many creative ways to address this shortage of vocations that will still enable the faithful to partake in daily and weekend Masses with perhaps some modifications to times, days and church locations. This is something none of us may want but what we are all facing.

Please continue to pray for more vocations as well as encouraging those that you feel might make good priests to consider this possibility. On Monday, June 29th, Cardinal Cupich will be ordaining 7 men as priests to serve our archdiocese. They are: Larry Josue Basbas, Arthur Bautista, Ismael Garcia Sainz, Patrick Gorman, Vinicio Jimenez, Henry (Hank) Lyon, Martin Marulanda and Patrick Bergin. Please keep them all in your prayers as they eagerly begin their new priestly ministries serving God's people.

Dear Family of Saint Eugene

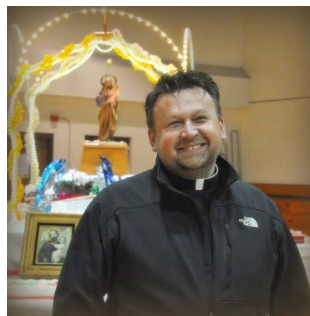

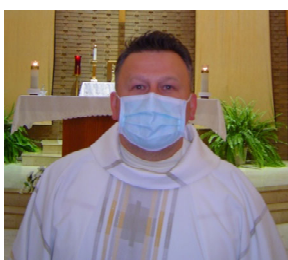
