From the desk of Father Rich Yanos



Happy 1 year anniversary to all in our Queen of Peace Parish family! Believe it or not it was a year ago this week that the merging of our three parishes of Divine Savior, Our Lady, Mother of the Church and St. Eugene took place on July 1st, 2022. I thought it would be interesting to look back at what I wrote in my bulletin column a year ago this weekend.

"To all in our parishes of Divine Savior, Our Lady, Mother of the Church and St. Eugene...this weekend begins a new chapter in the history of our newly uniting parish. Welcome aboard! The days, weeks and months ahead will be filled with much activity, new information and hopefully new opportunities for growth, renewed hope, and a deeper relationship with Jesus Christ and one another. I so look forward to participating and sharing in this new journey with us all. I hope you do as well. There may be mistakes made along the way, but hopefully we can learn something about ourselves as we pick ourselves up and recover from them. Rather than being frightened, fearful and afraid of what is to come I pray that we look to our future together with openness, anticipation, honesty, excitement, and enthusiasm. As I have said so many times before, with the Lord at our side we can move mountains together. Today, we begin this journey as we take our first steps!"

Well, it's now been one year, and we are all still here. To be honest with you I am so pleased and proud of the transition and progress we have made working with one another in bringing our three parishes together. It certainly hasn't been easy but little by little, one step at a time, we move forward in our understanding and appreciation of one another and all that is yet to be discovered and experienced. I thank you all for your cooperation and willingness to make this journey together.

I wanted to give you a little update on the progress of the relocation of the statue of the Queen of Peace. As you can see the masons are busy erecting and laying the stones for the pedestal/base that will support the Queen of Peace statue. Laying these stones is really a work of art in itself. It won't be long before the statue is in place. First, however, it will have to be cleaned and then secured to the pedestal.

Some have been asking me how the donations have been coming in regarding the contributions for this project which will include lighting, landscaping and hopefully benches. To date a little over \$11,000 has been donated. I thank all those who are making contributions toward our goal of truly beautifying this area where the Queen of Peace will be located. We are still looking for someone in our parish who might be willing to donate their services of providing a landscape design for this area that we would like to see used as a prayer/meditation area. Some have even suggested incorporating paving stones that parishioners can contribute toward to memorialize a loved one or even themselves. As this project comes together, I will keep you informed regarding our progress and possibilities.

This Tuesday, July 4th, our country will celebrate Independence Day. We have much to be grateful for as citizens of this great and free nation. I invite you to begin the celebration of this day by joining your fellow parishioners at Our Lady, Mother of the Church for Mass at 9:00 a.m., if only to give thanks to God for all that we've been blessed with, both personally and as a nation.

This year will be special in that our 4th of July Mass will be celebrated at Our Lady, Mother of the Church rather than at St. Eugene, because Tuesdays are when daily Mass is celebrated there. So, everyone will be gathering at Our Lady, Mother of the Church for a 9:00 a.m. Mass. Please make a note of this. There will not be the usual 7:00 a.m. Mass on this day. I hope that as many as possible from each of our former parish communities will join together to celebrate our National Day of Independence.

Divine Savior's Marian Shrine, Now known as the Queen of Peace Statue, Will be coming to a new location!

The Unification Committee has approved the relocation of the beautiful Marian Shrine, from the campus of Divine Savior, to Saint Eugene's Church. The shrine was erected by the parishioners in 1987, and was ironically named the Queen of Peace, the name of our new parish. It is fitting that she is moved to the new location.

The Queen of Peace is an 8' stainless steel sculpture weighing 1,200 pounds. The brick base that she sits on cannot be moved and will need to be reconstructed. 3G Construction has been hired to move the statue and replicate the base. The owners of 3G Construction are long-time active parishioners. The statue will be placed in a prominent place along Foster Ave.

We are asking for your financial support for the success of this project. Our goal is to raise \$30,000 which will cover the relocation cost, build a new base, beautify the landscape around the statue, and include lighting and benches.

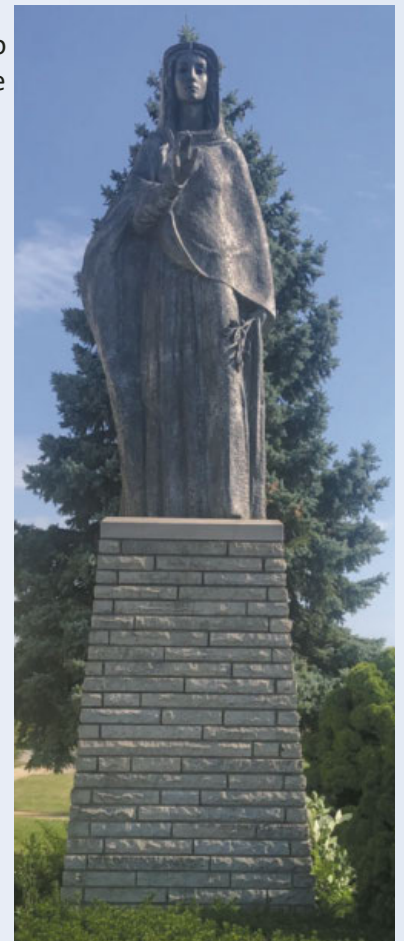
As we move into the future, we are certain that the Blessed Mother, the Queen of Peace, will reign in our hearts and in her new location as we unite under her mantle.

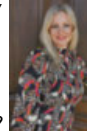
