Bishop Robert Casey celebrated a beautiful and meaningful Mass for our candidates and their families and friends. To the Confirmation Class of 2023, may this be the beginning of a stronger and more meaningful relationship with Jesus and his Church. Congratulations to your families as well.

Wednesday, November 1st, is ALL SAINT'S DAY – A Holy Day of Obligation. This means that all Catholics are obliged to attend Mass on this day to celebrate and honor those men and women of days gone by, that have led and modeled for us, exemplary lives of faithfulness and solid Christian living. We will offer four Masses on Wednesday, November 1st. At St. Eugene there will be Masses at 9:00 a.m. and at 7:00 p.m. At Our Lady Mother of the Church there will be Masses at 7:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.

On Thursday, November 2nd, we will celebrate the Commemoration of all the Faithful Departed with ALL SOUL'S DAY. Masses on All Soul's Day will be celebrated at both parishes as well. Morning Mass on Nov. 2nd will be celebrated at Our Lady Mother of the Church at 7:00 a.m. At St. Eugene Church Masses will be at 7:00 p.m. with a special celebration at the 7:00 p.m. Mass. All in our community are invited and encouraged to attend this special evening Mass to honor and remember your deceased loved ones. This Mass will be a powerful expression of remembrance for those who have gone before us, not only in our parish community but within our own families as well.

Also, on All Soul's Day, November 2nd, Queen of Peace Parish will have Shrines of Remembrance of our beloved dead at each worship site. At St. Eugene Church, the Shrine will be in the sanctuary. You are invited to bring pictures of your deceased loved ones and place them on the tables in the vestibule. At Our Lady, Mother of the Church, the Shrine will be in the narthex (gathering space). Please bring pictures of your deceased loved ones and place them on the tables there. For all pictures, please place a sticker or tag with your name, address, and phone number on the back of each picture. These pictures may be picked up the weekend of November 11-12.

In addition, if you would like to remember your deceased loved ones in another special way, you may write their names in the spaces provided on the special All Soul's Day envelope that was included in your October Sunday envelope packet. If you do not have these envelopes, you can simply write the names of your deceased loved ones on a piece of paper and place them in a plain envelope with your offering.

The envelopes can be placed in the regular Sunday offering or brought to the parish office. The names that you submit will then be published in our parish bulletin within one or two weeks (this is so we can gather all the names submitted that often come in after All Soul's Day) and placed upon the altar during the month of November and throughout the year.

We hope that this time of prayer together will renew our hope and heal our pain and grief. In the sharing of our grief, we believe that our grief is diminished. May our loving God continue to bless and comfort you as you mourn the loss and celebrate the memories of your loved ones.

Next weekend, October 28/29, Queen of Peace Parish is inviting First Responders and their families to join us at all the Masses.

Living Rosary

Blessed Pauline Marie Jaricot, who founded the Living Rosary, is also the founder of the Pontifical Mission Society for the Propagation of the Faith. People would pray daily and make a weekly monetary sacrifice. The first collection in 1822 went to the diocese of Louisiana, which then ranged from the Florida Keys to Canada, and also went to the missions of Kentucky and China. In the Living Rosary, people each pray a decade of the Rosary daily for the triumph of the Immaculate Heart of Mary, and in honor of Saint Philomena, who is the patron of the Living Rosary. Through Saint Philomena's intercession, Blessed Pauline received a miraculous healing. The next available decade is the third Glorious Mystery, the Descent of the Holy Spirit. 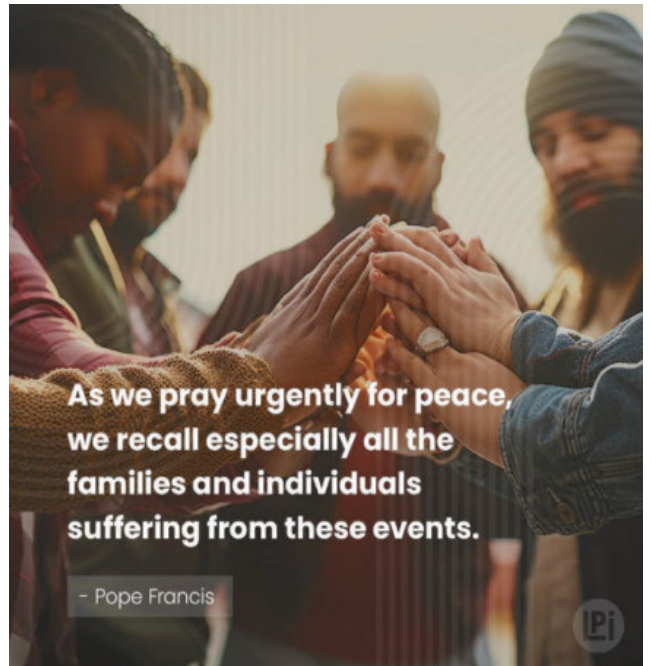

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

We, the Catholic bishops of Illinois, write with a sense of urgency. Unless the General Assembly acts to renew the Invest in Kids scholarship program, more than 9,000 children currently relying on this program to attend a non-public school may have their educational path disrupted. Without an extension of the program in Illinois law now, no scholarships will be awarded for the school year that will begin in September 2024. Most of these children will have to leave the school their families determined was their best chance to receive a high-quality education in a safe and wholesome learning environment. This is an injustice that should and can be avoided, but only if the General Assembly acts when it reconvenes on October 24, 2023.

Invest in Kids has proven to be a beacon of hope for thousands of Illinois students and their families. Children receiving Invest in Kids scholarships come from lower-income families who could not otherwise afford tuition at the Catholic or another non-public school that is the best fit for their child. Childhood is a limited time in the life of a human being and primary and secondary education is not something that can be put off to some future date when it is convenient for adults. This is our one chance to offer these Illinois children a good start. Please help keep education options available and a brighter future possible by contacting your state senator and state representative and telling them to continue the Invest in Kids Program.

Since its inception six years ago, Invest in Kids has generated overwhelmingly positive results. Nearly 40,000 scholarships have been awarded to students attending non-public schools across Illinois. Demand for scholarships is very high - for every scholarship granted, three students are turned down due to lack of funds. Contrary to what you may have heard, this is not a voucher program, nor does it take state funds away from the public schools. These scholarships are funded through contributions from donors who receive a tax credit for their donation on their Illinois state income tax.

What can you do to help? Please contact your state senator and state representative to let them know of your support for extending the Invest in Kids tax credit scholarship program in Illinois. We also encourage you to urge your fellow parishioners to do the same. Our collective voice is vital to the continued help for Illinois families.
