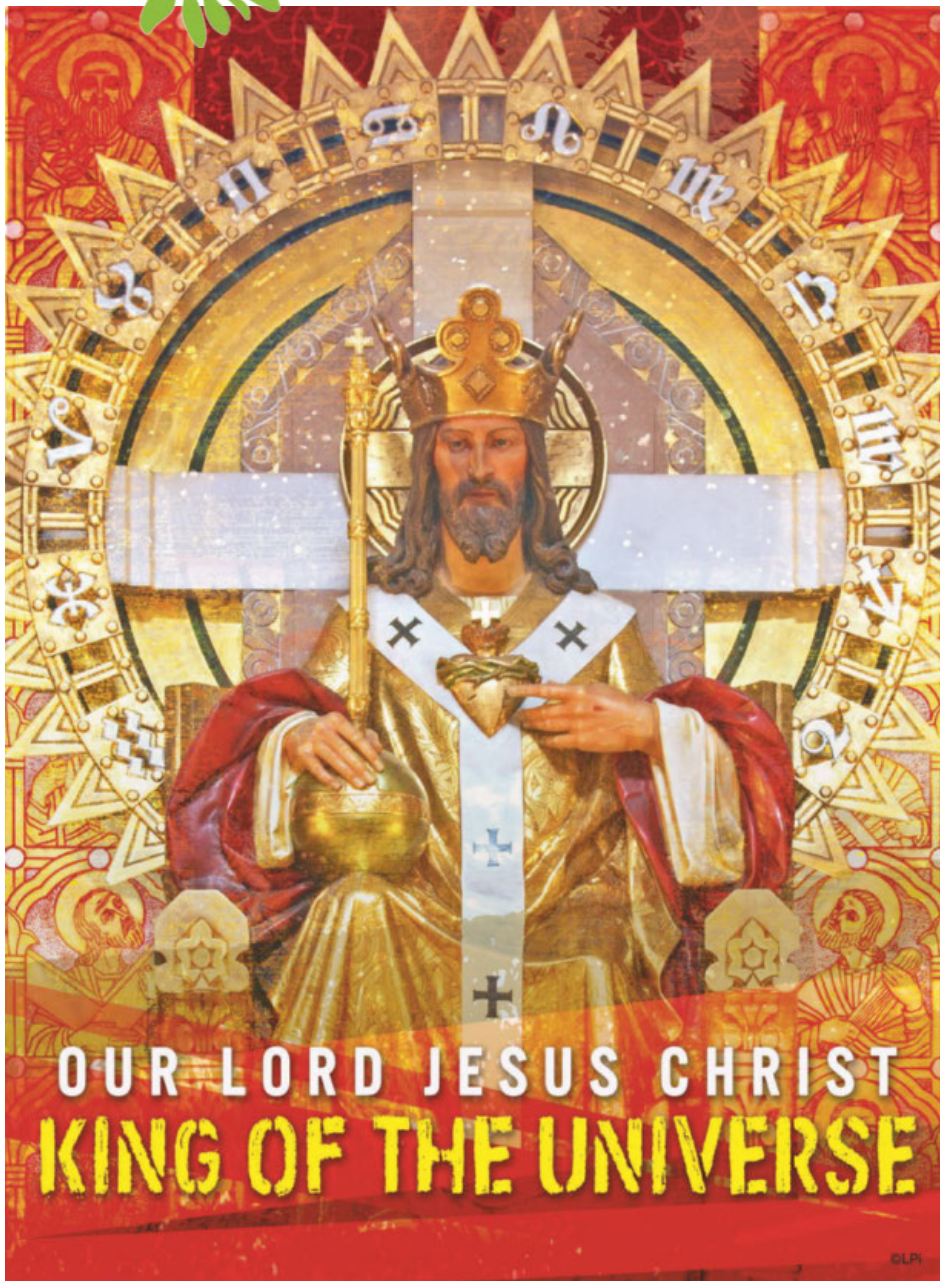

From the desk of Father Rich Yanos

Today, the Church celebrates the last Sunday of the liturgical year with the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe. Our attention is drawn to that time when life as we experience it here on earth, ends, and eternal life begins. The first reading from Ezekiel and the Gospel of Matthew makes clear the certainty of a final judgment where all people will hear their eternal destiny. The second reading from the First Letter of St. Paul to the Corinthians assures the baptized that Christ is truly alive and reigning and that the divine plan for humans to enjoy God's life forever is moving towards its fulfilment.

This is certainly good news for each of us trying our best to make our way to the Kingdom. Throughout our lives we may stray from the teachings of God and His Church. We may wander from what we know is the right path to take in life for a myriad of reasons. We may even consciously choose to abandon the will of God by not putting our faith into practice by keeping holy the sabbath day and by not providing for the needs of our most needy brothers and sisters. Fortunately, as Ezekiel reminds us today, as a shepherd tends his flock so too, will God tend his lost sheep. He will seek out the lost, the strayed he will bring back, the injured he will bind up and the sick he will heal.

But we must also never forget how Ezekiel says God will deal with the sleek and the strong. These, he says, the Lord will destroy "with justice." The meaning of this final phrase, which is translated as "shepherding them rightly" is that the Lord will tend to the wellbeing of all the members of the flock, seeing that they get what they need and deserve.

Still, we are all reminded that God's people, like their leaders, will be judged for their faithfulness to Him. Something we might all be thinking about as we make our upcoming Advent journey to Christmas and our earthly journey to God's Kingdom.

Our 2024 Parish calendars are now available. You can pick one up on your way out of church at all the exit doors. Please be sure to pick one up. They will be available at these doors until all are taken.

I just wanted to remind all in our parish community that our Saturday evening Mass time will be changing beginning on the first weekend of January which happens to be January 6th . (Only 6 weeks away). The 5:00 p.m. Mass will be moving a half an hour earlier to 4:30 p.m. Confessions will also be moving a half an hour earlier from 4:00 p.m. to 3:30 p.m. Please make a note of this change, especially those that attend the Saturday evening Mass.

I also want to share some thoughts in response to a question many of my friends as well as parishioners ask me often. “How have things been going with regard to the merging of three parishes”? My response frequently comes as a surprise to many because they share with me some of the challenges they have had to go through in their own parishes. Quite honestly, I am so grateful for the spirit of cooperation that I can truly say has been my experience so far with this process over the past almost two years now. Let’s face it, none of us likes what we have had to go through. No one wants to have to move from one church to another. Certainly, no one wants to experience the process of closing their church. Yet, all these things are what our parishioners have been faced with recently. I am convinced that we will get through this process over the next many years, and we will become even stronger as a family of faith so long as we continue to accept one another, are willing to work with each other, and are cooperative with each other.

We are most certainly in the early stages of where we could or want to be. Getting to know one another and the new faces we see coming together now in our new worship sites takes time. Patience is something I am not personally good at but am now learning along the way. They say, “a journey of a thousand miles begins with a single step” and I feel we as a newly formed parish are taking single steps that will eventually get us to where we want to be.

I am so grateful to the spirit of openness and collaboration that I feel when our Unification Committee gathers every month. More recently we have been meeting with Samantha Polo and Rick Moreno, Parish Vitality Coordinators who are with the Archdiocesan Department of Parish Vitality and Mission, as we are beginning to plan our next steps in the process of becoming a more evangelizing parish. You will be hearing much more about where we hope to go in the future and how we hope to accomplish our goals.

Finally, I would like to offer my thanks and gratitude to all those on our Liturgical Art and Decorating Committee. Week after week, liturgical season after another, special event after special event you go about the work of keeping our church and sanctuary always looking fresh and beautiful and decorated so seasonally appropriate. As an associate pastor in a couple of parishes I served in the past, I know the time and effort that goes into what you do. On behalf of our entire parish I just want to say, “Thank You” for the great job you do for us all!

In May 2023, for the first time in almost three quarters of a century, a monarch was crowned in England. A few days later a friend of mine scoffed, "What a waste of time and energy! What is the point of a king?"

I'm a proud American who wants neither theocracy nor monarchical restoration. I like our democratic republic. But the coronation of King Charles reminded me of something needed in every person and community: confidence in the future. The king's most basic role is to symbolize the unity of the nation. In England, the parliament members handle many of the practical duties of governance. But the king or queen can do what they cannot: embody in a single person the reality and future of a whole nation. To say, "this is our king" is to say, "we exist as a community, and we have a future." Kingship isn't primarily about the power of one person or family. It's about the enduring identity and unity of the whole.

To say Christ is our King is to say we exist as a people. We are one in him. We are, and we will be as long as he is. And since he will be our risen king forever, together we have a future filled with hope. Even the best countries will finally fall. But Christ and his Church will endure forever. What good news! It's not a waste of time to crown a king. We do it all the time. Let's be sure to crown the right one — the one whose kingdom never ends.
