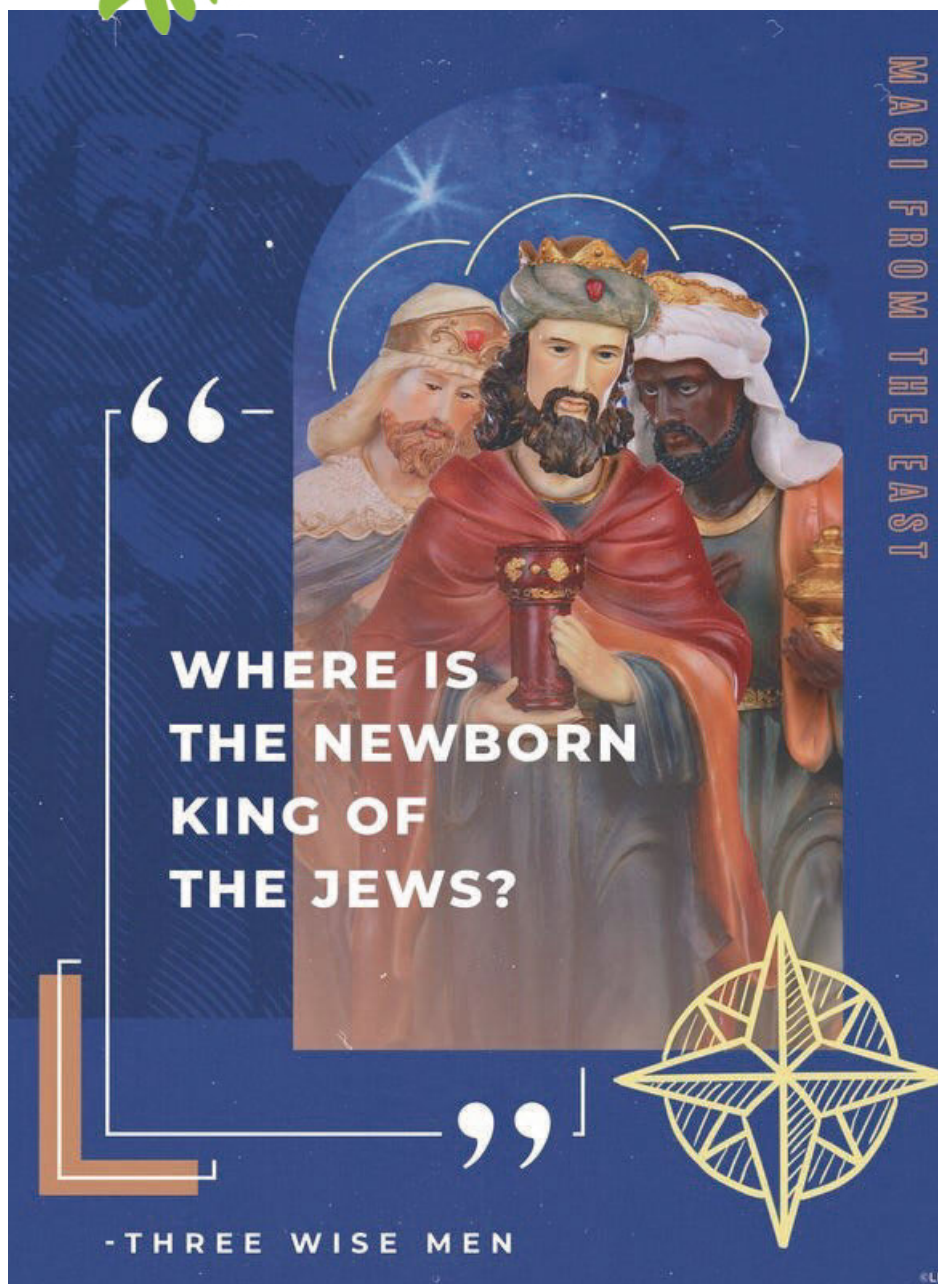

January 7th, 2024 | The Epiphany of the Lord



From the desk of
Father Rich Yanos



This weekend our Church celebrates the Solemnity of the Epiphany of the Lord. This day has been celebrated since the third century in the East and since the fourth century in the West. It is a celebration of the Lord's incarnation as the making known of God's presence among us.

The gospel we hear proclaimed today portrays reason and revelation working closely together to lead us to Christ – a journey that can be completed only by the gift of faith. Using their science, the Magi arrived in Jerusalem. There these “non-Jews” or Gentiles consult the Jewish revelation to determine the route to their goal of finding the Christ-child, for reason alone cannot bring us finally to Christ. But the revealed word in and of itself seems insufficient as well, since the scribes who gave instruction to the Magi, based on the interpretation of the scriptures, do not make the journey themselves or even with the Magi for that matter. Perhaps Matthew is telling his mixed community of believers, and our own community, that none of us has it all together, but that together we have it all.

As I reflect on this thought I am drawn to look at our own community of faith here at Queen of Peace and the gifts each of us bring to the Lord's Table and to each other. As your priest and pastor, I am fully aware of my shortcomings and the things that are lacking in my ability to better shepherd our community of faith. Yet, what is lacking in me does not discourage me, because I am also aware of the unique gifts and talents that are represented here in YOU -- the good people of this parish. As any successful pastor will tell you, it is in the collective recognition and use of the many gifts given us by God that creates a holy people and an effective parish community. It is in the working together with each other that we bring about God's kingdom among us.

Not a day goes by in the life of our parish that I am not reminded of how we are richly blessed because of the shared goodness of the dedicated members of our community. I want to thank everyone in our parish (our parish and school staffs, my brother priests, our resident Verbum Dei Sisters, and parishioners) for helping to make our Christmas season together the wonderful celebration that it has been and continues to be. Great things happen when we work side-by-side, and I am always grateful and proud of what we have accomplished and continue to do together here at Queen of Peace especially with the recent unification of our three parish communities.

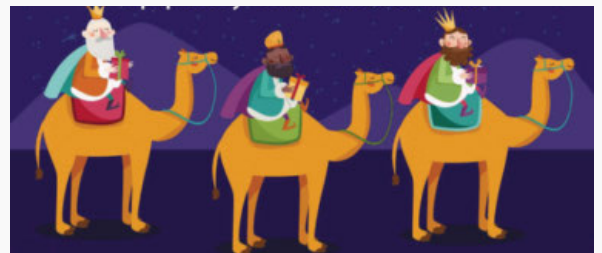
May 2024 be a year of new opportunities, good health, and renewed faith for us all!

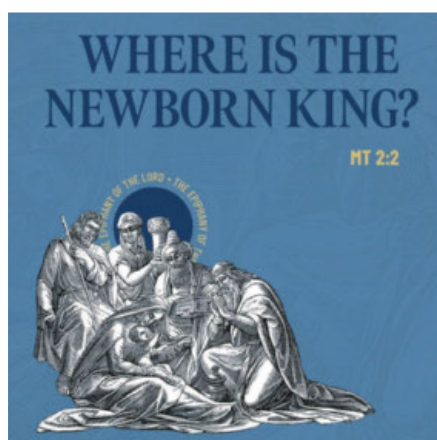

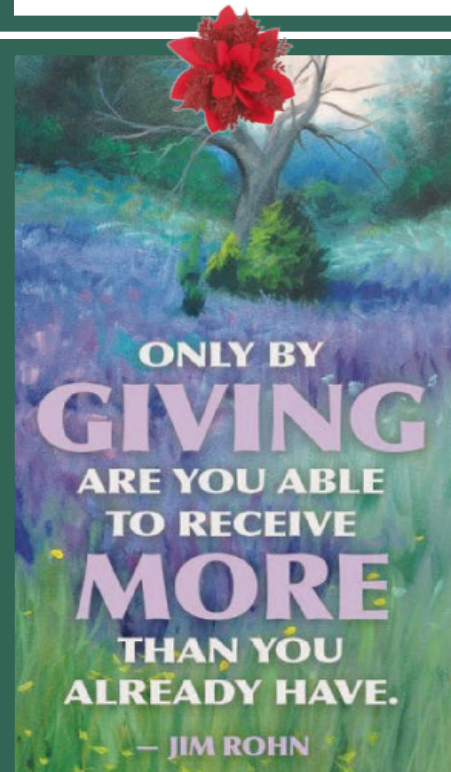

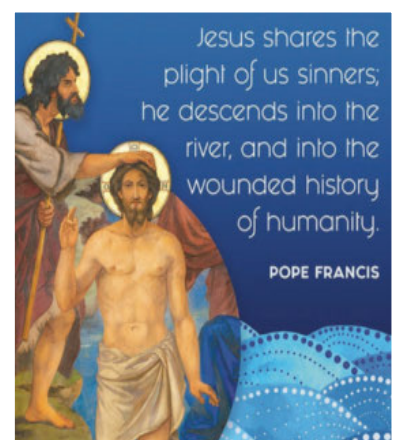

Living Rosary

Tuesday, January 9th is the feast day of Blessed Pauline Jaricot, who started the Living Rosary after Pope Leo XII asked Catholics to pray the Rosary for the protection of the Church and the world. About ten years later, Blessed Pauline's health was poor, and she heard stories of miracles through the intercession of Saint Philomena. Blessed Pauline made a pilgrimage to the shrine and relics of St. Philomena on the saint's feast day, and received healing through St. Philomena's intercession. Today the Living Rosary is prayed for the triumph of the Immaculate Heart of Mary, which includes protection of the Church and the world, and in honor of St. Philomena. The Announcement of Easter and the Moveable Feasts

On the Epiphany of the Lord, in keeping with an ancient practice of Holy Church, the moveable feasts of the current year are announced according to this formula.

Know, dear brothers and sisters, that, as we have rejoiced at the Nativity of our Lord Jesus Christ, so by leave of God's mercy we announce to you also the joy of his Resurrection, who is our Savior.

On the **14th day of February** will fall **Ash Wednesday**, and the beginning of the fast of the most sacred Lenten season.

On the **31st day of March** you will celebrate with joy **Easter Day**, the Paschal feast of our Lord Jesus Christ.

On the **12th day of May** will be the **Ascension of our Lord Jesus Christ**.

On the **19th day of May**, the feast of **Pentecost**.

On the **2nd day of June**, the feast of the **Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ**.

On the **1st day of December**, the **First Sunday of the Advent** of our Lord Jesus Christ, to whom is honor and glory for ever and ever. Amen.

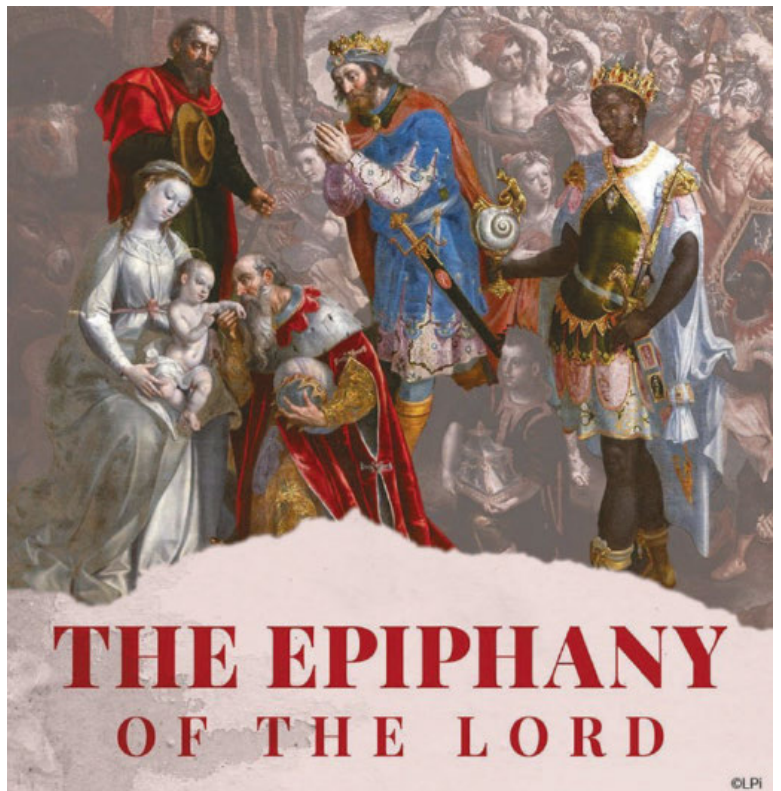

Gospel Meditation

Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture

A stranger in a foreign land, I was exhausted and homesick as my summer Spanish immersion ended in Guatemala. The rusty minivan arriving outside my small residence filled me with joyful hope. I was flying home to the U.S. and would be, at long last, completely happy. Or so I thought. After about half an hour of being home, I thought to myself, "This place is boring. I want to go somewhere." So, I hopped in my car and left to see my friends. As I drove, I wistfully wondered, "Where am I truly at home?"

The feast of Epiphany has a lot to do with our notion of home. Where is our origin? Where are we going? When is our wandering done? Saint Matthew tells us of the Magi, "**They were overjoyed at seeing the star.**" This star will bring them home, to a place where their questing will end, and they will be satisfied. Their real home is neither in the East nor in the earthly Jerusalem. Somehow, their home is wherever this boy and his parents are.

If you're a teenager or older, you probably know by now that every physical home we have is temporary. So, we look up at the countless stars in our proverbial skies: things which bedazzle and beckon us to follow toward peace. The Gospel invites us to behold that — at long last — God has sent us a star to follow home, one that whispers, "Follow me! I will take you home!" Perhaps that star is your spouse. A friend. An opportunity. A cause. An intuition about a new direction. A prayer group. What is it for you? How will you know? It will lead you to Mary and Joseph and their son, and you will be home.

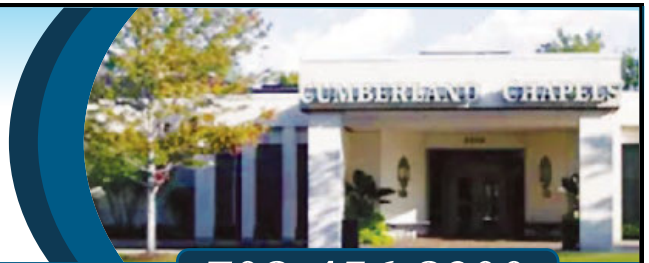

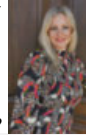
