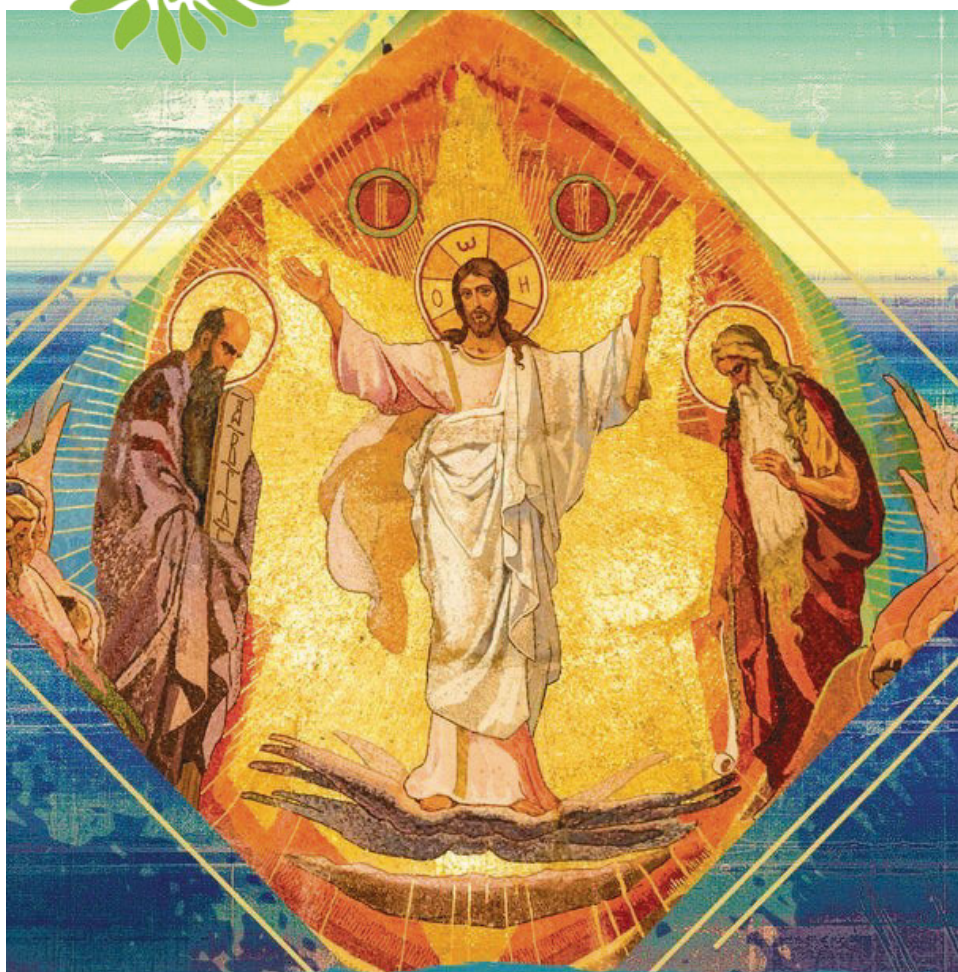

## *From the desk of* *Father Rich Yanos*

Today we are celebrating the Second Sunday of Lent.

The events in today's first reading from the Book of Genesis took place approximately 1800 years before Christ. In that pagan culture, child sacrifice was common. That's why Abraham believed God wanted him to sacrifice his only son, Isaac. Later generations constantly looked back to this event as an example of Abraham's great faith.

Today's second reading from Romans is part of a hymn that celebrates God's love and which concludes the eighth chapter of Paul's letter to the Romans. In our first reading we heard how God spared Abraham's only son; in this passage we will hear how, out of love for us, God did not spare his only son.

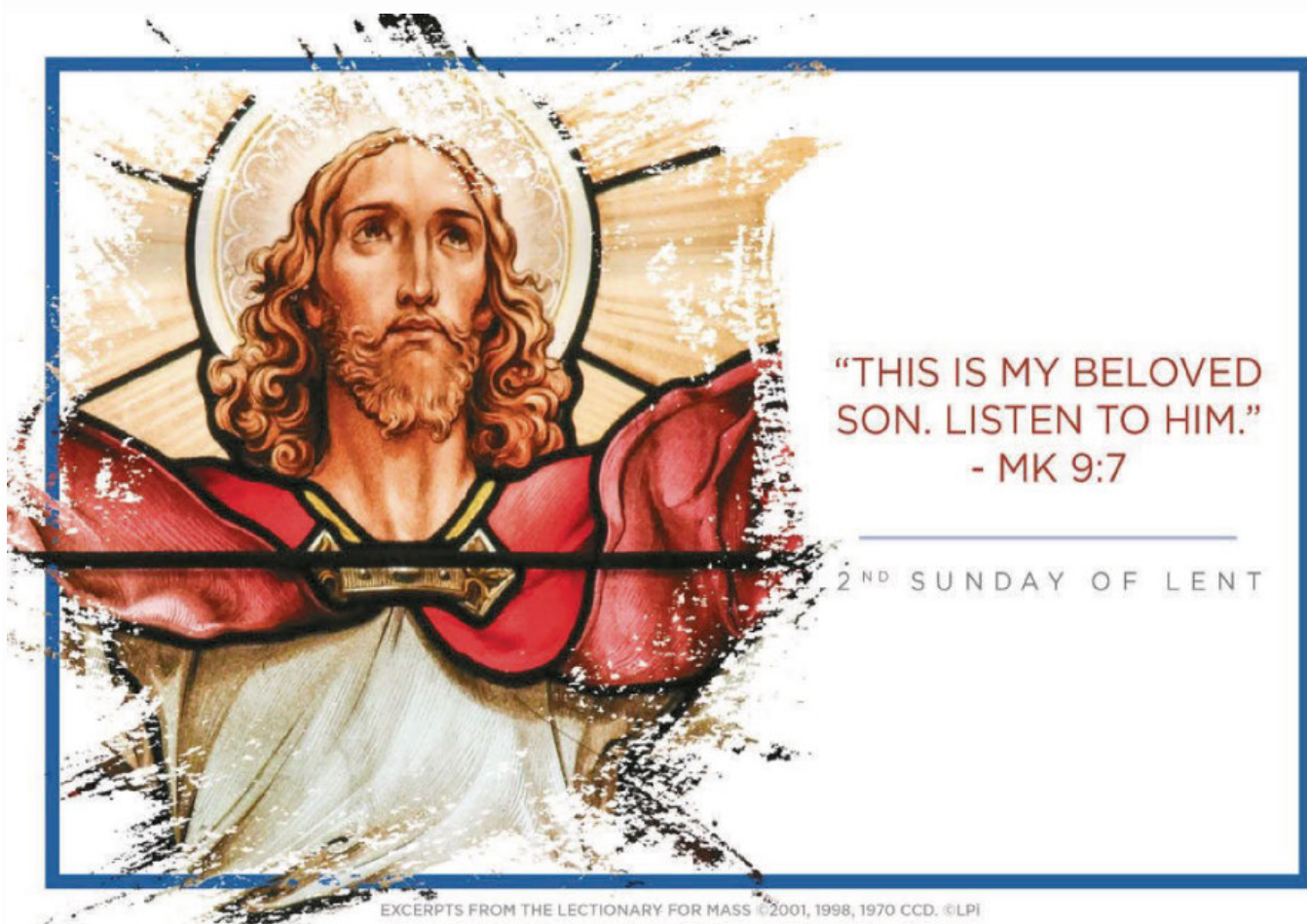
We always have a great time on these trips. Hope you can join us.

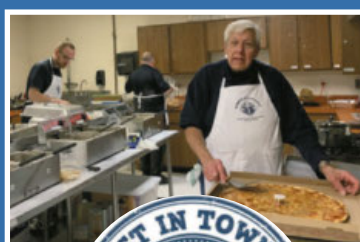

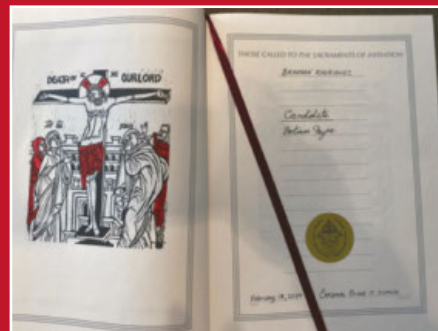

## Rite of Election at Holy Name Cathedral 2024 February 18, 2024

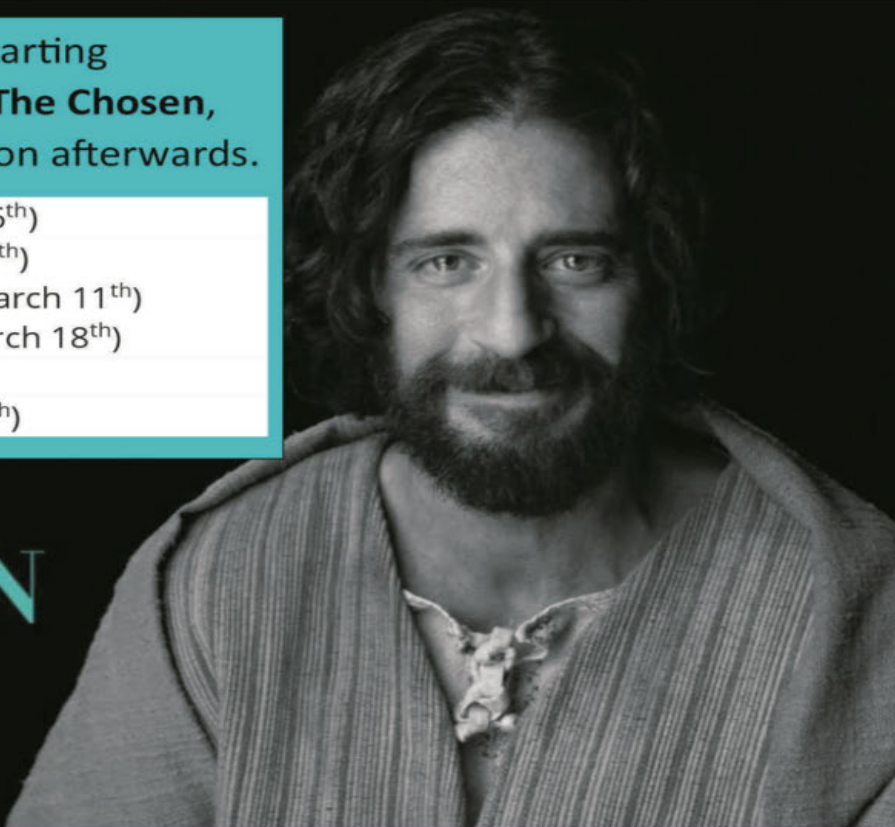

For more than 30 years, the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) has worked to restore a visible, active Church in Central and Eastern Europe and to build a hopeful new future in Georgia, Kyrgyzstan, and more than 25 other countries throughout the region. 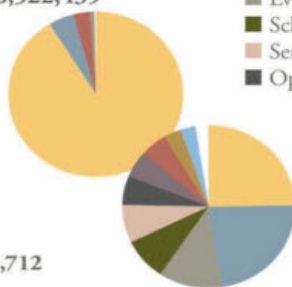

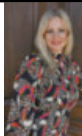
