# COMMEMORATION OF ALL FAITHFUL DEPARTED

The Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed, more commonly known as All Souls' Day, expresses our faith in the unity of all members of the church including those who are no longer among the living. This day of remembering and praying for the dead began in monastic communities in the early Middle Ages. By the eleventh century, it had a fixed date of November 2nd, and by the fourteenth century, it was a celebration of the entire church. The liturgy for All Souls' Day resembles the funeral liturgy in vesture, music, readings, and prayers.

Greetings Parishioners:

Thank you for another successful year for Queen of Peace. Without your support, we would not be where we are today.

As we look forward to our future, we will be looking at ways to engage and involve the younger members of our parish families. Our future will be as bright as we are willing to make it. I so look forward to what lies down the road as we continue Renew the Church as the People of God as we are called to be.

I am happy to present the 2024 - 2025 Annual Report for your viewing. As we are all aware, sustaining this spiritual home is costly, but it is so worth the spend as we are able to gather together every week.

During this past fiscal year, the following capital improvements have included:

- HVAC work amongst the Queen of Peace campus buildings, including the church, school, convent, and rectory = \$238,058.
- St. Eugene church masonry and rectory work = \$349,833.
- Furnishings for church improvements inclusive of sound system and WiFi = \$46,135.

We are working with the Arch to get more clarity on the bids from engineers and contractors to address the parking lots at both St. Eugene and Our Lady, Mother of the Church. So far, there is a range of cost from \$350K - \$2MM.

With the returns from the Generation to Generation campaign spanning over the next few years, we will have some funds to continue the efforts of maintaining our spiritual home. This includes expanding our project list to looking at replacement of the flooring in the church.

As always, thank you all for your participation, allegiance, and patience, as we work through the projects to maintain the beauty of Queen of Peace Parish.



# ST. EULALIA'S QUINN CENTER

## “THE CUPBOARD IS BARE”



“The cupboard is bare” is definitely not what we expected to hear after the October 14 grocery distribution at St. Eulalia’s Quinn Center. But that was certainly the case. On the previous Sunday, Queen of Peace volunteers had filled 85 bags of groceries. When added to the 35 left over from the previous month, we had an inventory of 120 bags to share. But 143 families, consisting of over 650 people, completely wiped that out. Fifteen additional bags were put together from items left on the shelves, so a total of 135 bags of groceries were distributed. (A few people come only for the bagged supper and not for groceries.) The shelves are now really bare.

Usually, there is an ebb and flow of people coming through the parking lot. Not that day. Coordinator Martha Minnich told us it was a constant stream of cars from 4:00 on. We’re not sure what caused the sudden jump in numbers, but we can assume ICE activity and furloughs and funding cuts from the government shutdown are coming into play. If you’re not able to go out to work, there’s no money coming in. If you are dependent upon SNAP and other government programs, your budget has just taken a major hit.

**November 9** will be our next grocery bagging session, and a lot of groceries will have to be purchased to prepare for that day. Several weeks out (as this is being written), we’re estimating that our target will have to be 150 bags – the highest number we’ve ever prepared. Needless to say, volunteers are very welcome. That’s a lot of groceries to organize. If you can’t join us physically, your prayers and financial support are also vital. Queen of Peace is the sole supplier for the food pantry.
