

FROM THE DESK OF FR. RICH

Today, we celebrate The Dedication of the Lateran Basilica in Rome.

When the Emperor Constantine granted full liberty to Christians in 313, many churches were constructed quickly. Constantine himself also constructed churches, one of which was a magnificent basilica on the Caelian Hill in Rome, over the ancient Lateran Palace, which Pope Sylvester I dedicated to Christ the Savior in the year 318. A chapel dedicated to Saint John the Baptist was built inside it which served as a baptistry. This moved Pope Sergius III to dedicate it to Saint John the Baptist as well. Lastly, Pope Lucius II also dedicated it to Saint John the Evangelist in the 12th century. Thus, the name of this Papal Basilica is the Basilica of the Most Holy Savior and of Saints John the Baptist and John the Evangelist in the Lateran. Christians consider the Basilica to be the mother church of all churches in the world.

The church was destroyed several times in the course of the centuries and was always rebuilt. The final reconstruction took place under the pontificate of Benedict XIII. The church was rededicated in 1724. It was at that time that the feast celebrated today was established and extended to the Universal Church.

I would like to encourage everyone to come over to the Shaunessy Center after the morning Masses today (Sunday), from 7:30 a.m. to 11:00 a.m., to enjoy a delicious pancake breakfast provided by

our Knights of Columbus. If you have never come to one of these breakfasts before you are in for a real treat and quite a variety of items to choose from. Give it a try, you won't be sorry. Hope to see you there.

Just an early reminder that Thursday, November 27th, is Thanksgiving Day. As is our tradition, we will be having Mass at 9:00 a.m. on that day. This year we will be celebrating Thanksgiving Day Mass at Our Lady, Mother of the Church (not the usual time of 7:00 a.m.) This will be the only Mass celebrated on Thanksgiving when we will gather as a parish family to give thanks to God for all His blessings in our lives and nation.

I truly encourage all in our parish to join us for this special Mass, even if this has not been your practice in the past. What better way to start off this national holiday than to gather around the Lord's Table before we come together later in the day to celebrate with family and friends. If this is not the case for you, let *us* be your family on Thanksgiving morning. So, pop the turkey in the oven and plan on joining us around the Lord's Table with your Queen of Peace parish family this Thanksgiving at Our Lady, Mother of the Church at 9:00 a.m.

I would like to offer my thanks and gratitude to all those on our Liturgical Art and Decorating Committee. Week after week, liturgical season after another, special event after special event you
