

FROM THE DESK OF FR. RICH

This weekend the liturgical year comes to a close with the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe. (Formerly – Christ the King). The irony of this day is in the connection between the kingship of Christ and the wood and the suffering of the cross. The way of God’s Kingdom is not the way of earthly kingdoms. The road to our eternal home involves suffering and service to one another. This is in direct conflict with the understanding and comprehension of earthly kings and kingdoms of the past. Hopefully, we have all come to better understand that God’s ways are not always our ways.

This coming Thursday, November 27th, is Thanksgiving Day. As is our tradition, we will be having Mass at 9:00 a.m. on that day (not the usual time of 7:00 a.m.). **Please note that this year our Thanksgiving Mass will be celebrated at Our Lady, Mother of the Church and not at St. Eugene Church. Because we have two worship sites and Thursday morning’s Mass is held at Our Lady, Mother of the Church, we will gather there this Thanksgiving. If you have not yet gone to our neighboring worship site, please join us.** This will be the only Mass celebrated on Thanksgiving when we will gather as a parish family to give thanks to God for all His blessings in our lives and nation.

I truly encourage all in our parish to join us for this special Mass, even if this has not been your practice in the past. What better way to start off this national holiday than to gather around the

Lord’s Table before we come together later in the day to celebrate with family and friends? And if this will not be the case for you, let *us* be your family on Thanksgiving morning. So, pop the turkey in the oven and plan on joining us around the Lord’s Table with your Queen of Peace family this Thursday.

Believe it or not, next Sunday we begin the Advent season and the time for each of us to get our lives in order and focus on preparing our hearts and homes for the coming of Christ. This time of the year encourages all Christian people to not only celebrate Christ’s Incarnation on the first Christmas, but also to prepare our hearts for his final and Second coming.

To help you and your family make the best of the upcoming Advent and Christmas Season, we have once again purchased “Little Blue Books” for you to carry with you, keep in your cars, family rooms, dinner tables, pockets, etc. This booklet is a great way to help you keep the Advent and Christmas Seasons with a prayerful and reflective time throughout each day. 
The Friendship Club will







Gospel Meditation

Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture

Not long ago, I was called to a hospital to anoint a woman in her early 80s. She was dying, and visibly in pain. But what struck me most wasn't her suffering — it was the atmosphere in the room. She had eight children and 30 foster kids, and many of them were gathered around her. You'd expect sorrow, fear, maybe even despair. But the room was filled with something else entirely — a quiet strength, a kind of sweetness. It was as if she was suffering not just with them, but for them. And they, in love, were suffering for her. The pain was real. But so was the peace. I didn't want to run. I felt as if I was in a little paradise, beeping machines and all.

I think of that moment when I hear today's Gospel. Jesus, hanging on the cross, doesn't look like a king. But one of the crucified, dying men beside him sees through the suffering and says, "**Jesus, remember me when you come into your kingdom**" (Luke 23:42). That word — *remember* — literally means to make someone a member again. He's asking to be joined to Christ, to become part of his Body. And Jesus says, "**Today you will be with me in paradise.**"

He doesn't say, "I'll take your suffering away." He says, "**You will be with me.**"

That's the strange power of Christ the King. He doesn't rule by avoiding suffering. He reigns by entering into it, and transforming it with love.

What are you suffering right now in your life? Likely you want it to stop. But if we are willing to suffer with him — paradise begins even today.
