

Scholastic Book Fair

The Scholastic online book fair begins Monday, February 1 and runs through midnight Sunday, February 14. That means you can shop any time, any day, even on weekends! Attached below is the link to access the fair and the thousands of titles available for purchase from the store. The virtual fair walks you through interactive cases as if you are visiting the fair at school and contains 200 plus new and premium titles. If you click on a book it will give you an age range and brief synopsis. You can also use the search engine to narrow books by grade level, genre, and author. Once you reach \$25 in books only, items are shipped for free directly to your house. A question pops up asking parents if they want to register with Scholastic. It is completely optional-you do not have to register. St. Theresa will still get the funds from the book fair regardless. You will receive a confirmation email with a cart that is very detailed about the contents. Books ship 10-14 days from date of purchase. A percentage of the fair sales allows us to purchase books for the library. Sales end on Feb. 14.

Teachers have begun setting up their **ewallets**. Ask them to share their link if they have not already done so. This enables parents to donate money to a teacher's ewallet and the teacher then uses those funds to purchase books for their classroom libraries. Teachers being able to purchase titles directly from the Scholastic book fair prevents duplicate titles being purchased by parents from a wish list. Any amount is appreciated.
