Counselor's Corner

Hello and I hope it was a wonderful week,

Pre-K and Kindergarten did a great job identifying goals and how to practice daily. Middle School reviewed the importance of being kind even in challenging situations. Next week in Pre-K and Kindergarten we will learn about having a growth mindset, and in middle school how to advocate for yourself.

This week's mindfulness activity is a fun spring project.

First get a stem of lettuce, basil, or green onion. Your child can check their plant daily to see how it is growing. Questions you can ask are how does it feel to see your plant grow? Does your plant have any smells, or colors? Is there anything you would like to tell your plant to help it grow? What kind words would you like to hear to help you grow?

- 1. Cut the leaves about 2 inches from the bottom stump.
- 2. Place the stem end in a dish with about an inch of water.

- 3. Place it in a sunny spot and watch it grow!
- 4. When there are several roots you can put your plant in a pot with soil or in your garden.

NOAA VWET Phytoplankton Pilot Program

Did you know that phytoplankton produces up to 50% of the oxygen in our atmosphere? Our 8th graders learned about this fun fact and much more!

The University of A&M at Galveston in cooperation with the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration invited our 8th graders to participate in a pilot program called the NOAA VWET Phytoplankton Lab Tour and Social Media Contest. This 360-degree virtual watershed education and training program allows students to take a virtual field trip to the phytoplankton lab at the University of A&M at Galveston which monitors the health of Galveston Bay.

This pilot program invited students all over Texas in grades 8-12 to participate and St. Theresa Catholic School is *one of only two middle schools to take advantage of this opportunity*. We are so excited that our students were able to complete the educational material designed for students in AP environmental science classes and complete a social media campaign to educate others about the importance of taking care of our watersheds.
