


STCS Policies and Procedures

- 4. Explain that the glitter in the water is like our feelings and everyone gets shaken-up from time-totime.

CMG Connect Training

The mission of the Archdiocese's "Safe Environment Program" is to insure the safety of children and young people who have been entrusted to our care in our parishes, schools, religious education classes, and other programs. The Archdiocese <u>requires</u> that any adult (parent, grandparent, aunt/uncle, sibling, etc.) who plans on volunteering at school, chaperoning a field trip, etc. receive this training. It is highly encouraged that all parents complete it before the start of the school year.

The training is online and takes approximately 1 hour to complete. You will be required to complete a criminal background check as part of the registration process. Please make sure you enter your

legal name as it appears on your Government Issued ID.

Please visit <u>CMG Connect</u> to complete the online training (<u>instructions here</u>). This certification is good for 5 years, if you have any questions regarding your current certification please reach out to Mayra Reyes at <u>m.reyes@sttheresa.cc</u>.

For new applicants, the application deadline to be considered in our first round of decisions for the 2024-2025 school year is **February 5, 2024**. We WILL continue to consider applications submitted after this date, so long as there is space in the grade. PK3 applicants must be three years old as of September 1, 2024 and toilet trained before school begins in August 2024.




4th Graders: Free Pass to Federal Parks, Land & Waters!
