HOLY TRINITY'S HISTORY

Holy Trinity Catholic High School opened for the first time in Temple in 1997 with an inaugural ninth grade class of 10 students from several parishes in the Temple Deanery. A tenth-grade class was added in 1998 and an eleventh in 1999. The first class graduated in May 2001.

MISSION

Holy Trinity Catholic High School strives to educate the Christian leaders of tomorrow; we seek to challenge the intellect, educate the heart, and form each student's character by giving witness to Gospel values.

DEMOGRAPHICS COMMUNITY

HTCHS serves an area of Central Texas comprised of three counties with an SMSA of 379,000. Temple, the site of the high school, is a community of 60,000, located 65 miles north of Austin on Interstate 35 and within 35 miles of Fort Hood, the largest military installation in the world.

Temple is a diverse community in which 53 per cent of the work force is employed in health care at Scott & White Memorial Hospital and Clinic and the Central Texas Veterans' Health Care System. Other primary employers are agricultural research, light industrial manufacturing and the military at Fort Hood. The presence of the third- and fourth-year programs of the Texas A&M Medical School, the medical facilities, the Blackland Research Center and cultural and historical resources in the community enhance the opportunities for youth in schools in Temple.

HTCHS is a partner with the Texas Bioscience Institute Middle College Program and the University of Mary Hardin-Baylor which allows HT students to attend college while still in high school and earn dual credit high school and college credits.

ACCREDITATION

As a school of the Austin Diocese, the school is under the direction of the Bishop of the Diocese and is accredited under the Texas Catholic Conference Education Department. The Texas Education Agency recognizes the TCCED as an accrediting agency. Holy Trinity Catholic High School meets the requirements established by the Advanced Accreditation Commission and is accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Council on Accreditation and School Improvement.

No grades from correspondence work, high school courses taken in middle school or special summer program courses are used in calculating either GPA.
