St. Anne Confirmation Program Requirements

Review the following Requirements and sign the bottom of the page that you understand them.

- Begin Confirmation classes at the earliest 9th grade and at the latest 11th grade.
- Be enrolled for two full years in the Confirmation program.
- Follow the attendance policies for the faith formation/ Confirmation programs.
 - After 3 absences, one-on-one makeups are required.
- 30 total volunteer hours
 - 10 Family
 - 10 St. Anne
 - 10 Community
- Attend Mass every Sunday and Holy Day or Obligation.
- Be a Practicing Catholic in good standing with the Catholic Church.
- Attend at least one Missions Retreat.
 - Missions Retreat 2022 registration is closed.
- Have a Confirmation Sponsor
 - Has been Baptized and Confirmed through the Catholic Church.
 - Is at least 16 years of age and eligible to receive communion
 - Is a practicing Catholic

Confirmation Sponsors also **pledge to:**

- Be a living example of faith.
 - Participate in the preparation process.
 - Pray with the confirmation student on a regular basis.
 - Be open to grow in their faith.
 - Check in with the student, even after confirmation.
- Choose a Confirmation Saint and write a report on them
 - Attend the Spring 2022 Super Saturdays.
