**From the Pastor's Office**

30th Sunday in Ordinary Time

I feel sympathy for Paul in his letter today. He sounds exhausted. He has good reason to be exhausted. He says, "I am already being poured out like a libation, and the time of my departure is at hand." Paul dedicated his whole life to the work of God. You never saw anyone with more dedication to the cause. He appeared to be fearless. When they tried to kill him, he got up and kept going. At the end he died in Rome. While he was waiting his fate he took the time to write letters to people like Timothy. When he couldn't be there himself, the next best thing was to send his thoughts and prayers. I especially feel a bit sad when Paul says that at his first defense nobody appeared on his behalf. I guess he was stood before the Roman court to answer. He did that alone. Paul says to all those who failed to appear, "May it not be held against them." He found his strength because he says that the Lord stood by him and gave him strength. I guess we all want that at the end. We want to do our endings well. Let me write my letters, let me say my farewells, let the Lord stand by me to give me strength.

The Pharisee in the Gospel parable is not anybody I would like to be friends with. Clearly arrogant, he prays his arrogance. "O God, I thank you that I am not like the rest of humanity." I know people like that. We don't spend much time together. The tax collector is all apology. Yet, tax collectors were generally regarded badly. They enjoyed taxing their fellow Jews in the name of Rome. We remember in another place Jesus talked about those who weigh the scales in their own favor. He was talking about tax collectors. This particular one is very sorry when he says, "God, be merciful to me a sinner." I appreciate his prayer but what must follow next is that he changes his ways and does good, does better than what he did before. Anyway, I hate that Pharisee. Just saying.

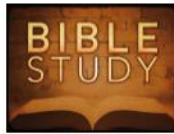

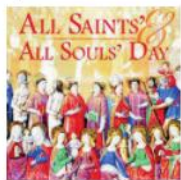
