

From the Pastor's Office

The Presentation of the Lord

The young parents bring their child to the Temple to receive a blessing from God. They came with thanksgiving in their hearts for the gift of their child. Every young parent comes before God and asks God to bless their child. They ask for God's protection and that their child grows to maturity, healthy and happy. It must have been a bit frightening when Simeon and Anna approached them in the crowd. Very quickly Simeon and Anna spoke prophetic words to Mary and Joseph. Some of these words were hard to take. A sword shall pierce their hearts because of this child. Had Mary and Joseph any idea what that meant? Maybe just a little bit scared, very quickly they made themselves scarce and went home to Nazareth. They fulfilled the requirement of the Law and now it was time to go home and be at home. The vocation theme continues in the readings today. The Prophet Malachi talks about the Lord whom you seek. "He is like the refiner's fire. He will sit refining and purifying silver and gold." The image is poetic. The metal is dipped into the blacksmith's forge and it is cleansed of any impurities. The metal emerges from the flames and it is pure. "Then the sacrifice of Judah and Jerusalem will please the Lord." We interpret these words to be words about the Messiah. He comes and He purifies. Paul speaks about the same thing in a parallel way. Jesus, through death, might destroy the one who has the power of death, that is the Devil, and free those subject to slavery. The image of refining by fire is useful to hold onto. Simeon and Anna in the Temple point us in a direction. Anna spoke about the child to all who were awaiting the redemption of Jerusalem. We enter a time of waiting. Let the child grow to maturity. The Messiah will reveal Himself in His own time.


