**From the Pastor's Office***Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time*

Jesus says in the Gospel today, "Therefore, whoever breaks one of the least of these commandments and teaches others to do so will be called least in the kingdom of heaven." You have been warned! We speak in our moral language about the danger of luring others into sin. We do that all the time. My favorite, because people tell me, is that they gossip all the time at work and at play. What they don't know they just make it up. We all love to be the center of the news. Everyone gathers around me because I have the most dirt. Isn't that the game we play? Jesus challenges us today. Jesus outlines his thoughts about various letters of the Mosaic Law. He speaks about killing. He speaks about adultery. He speaks about divorce. The general conclusion around all His thoughts is to say that most of the time we do the minimum. We don't want to be too inconvenienced. Forget about your killing! How about something more basic than that? How about the way you turn your anger into Opera. You explode it all over people. You don't care what damage you do to your family. You are angry and by God you are going to make sure we all know about it! Well, bravo to you. You have just killed us all. I hope you feel better. Forget about adultery! Long before adultery, you have sinned in every possible way you could. You were cunning and deceitful. You enjoyed your lust. If any part of you was the cause of sinning, insulting, and hurting other people, then shame on you. Forget about making your oath! "I swear to you on my mother's grave." We've heard it all before. I swear to you. Therefore you must believe me. "I swear to you, Mom, I never took that cookie," he said with crumbs all over his mouth. Don't mind you swearing. Just do it. Let your 'yes' mean yes. Let your 'no' mean no. That's what the Bible says. We love to do as little as possible. We do the minimum in all things. We love to display and spread our anger all around. We love to justify with all kinds of swearing oaths. We've heard it all before. Just do better, please.
