**From the Pastor's Office***Fifth Sunday of Easter*

Peter is very poetic in his letter today. I love these words. "Come to Him, a living stone rejected by human beings but chosen and precious in the sight to God, and, like living stones, let yourselves be built into a spiritual house to be a holy priesthood to offer spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ." The thing is stones are not living things. They are just stones. The idea of a living stone that contributes to the building of God's Kingdom is a lovely thing to consider. Paul used his own imagery when he says we are the Body of Christ all joined together with Christ as the Head. Peter is getting to be quite a preacher. Clearly, based on the first reading the early Christians made huge progress and many people wanted to join them. Many people previously experienced the worship of God as an alien thing. You worship the God. You pay your money and everything's fine for another while. The Christians proclaimed a faith that was based on an intimate personal relationship with God. They wanted to build a community of people who were joined together like family. We all want to belong to something like that. This Coronavirus has taught us an important lesson about community. We need each other. People matter. Without people I am dead. We begin to see this little group of believers getting more organized. From the beginning the Christians practiced the works of charity. They fed people. They cared for the vulnerable. Nobody was sent away. So, we have the situation arising about how to get better organized. In order to allow the Elders and Apostles to spend their days preaching the message, it was necessary to recruit people who could manage the distribution of the food. Good idea. The ministry of the Deacon was born in these days. Let there be men from the community who love God come forth to offer their lives in service. We see the beginning of Administration in the Community. We see the evolution of ritual. Once the decision was made the elders of the Community laid their hands on these seven men chosen for ministry. The laying on of hands is prominent in our liturgical practices today. I am amazed to read that the number of disciples in Jerusalem increased greatly. There arises a large group of priests. The Pharisees and Romans can't have been happy about that. It is like the Christians have broken through the fences that held them in. You can't stop us now. Very quickly in the early days, the Apostles began to spread across the known world. When you experience your faith like a living stone you just want to burst forth and spread the message. We all do that by our words and by our actions. You don't have to be a great theologian to be a good Christian. If you want to know how to be a good Christian, or to try it again, how about you begin by doing works of charity. Where? What? How? Well! Check out our bulletin. When everything gets back to normal maybe you might like to go out with Mobile Loaves and Fishes. Maybe you might like to get involved with St. Vincent de Paul's mission. Maybe you might like to join the thousand other ways we at St. Catherine of Siena parish reaches out. A thousand times you heard us ask people to take a grocery basket and fill it with some food. Our intention is to bring that food to Abiding Love Lutheran Church Food Bank. Every time we asked you to help you just ignored us and departed. How about this time you stop and do something? Take a grocery bag. Buy some groceries and let our community reach out to the poor with acts of charity. Try it out. It might do you good. Just saying...

Dear Parishioners and friends,

This is an official announcement on behalf of the Bishop of the Diocese of Austin. On April 30, Bishop Joe Vasquez issued a decree authorizing the parishes of the Diocese to begin to offer Masses and Sacraments with the people of the parish present. The celebration of public Masses will resume under very restricted conditions beginning Tuesday, May 5. **The Bishop has also given a dispensation from attending Mass to those over 65, those who have underlying health conditions or those who feel unsafe attending, and to those who live with persons in these circumstances.** The arrangements we are about to announce are temporary.

A reminder that we are in a time of pandemic. We do not have a vaccine. Our only method of keeping safe is social distancing. Many people have expressed alarm saying that we are opening too soon. Seeing the Church is open is not an announcement that the danger has passed. On April 23rd, we hit the 50,000 total number of deaths in the United States. Eleven days later, today that number is hitting 66,000 deaths. This is not the flu. This is a deadly virus. Projections expect us to hit over 100,000 deaths by August. The schedule I am about to announce is temporary. This will be subject to revision very quickly. Consider that many churches are going to open up now. We will watch and see what happens. If the virus begins to spread rapidly in the Churches, we will close immediately. If things improve we will gradually open up some more.

We will offer public daily Mass at St. Catherine of Siena on Monday through Friday at 12:00 p.m. We will require everyone who attends to continue with social distancing. We also require everyone present to wear a mask. If you don't wear a mask we will ask you to leave the church immediately. We will continue live streaming the daily Mass. We have also changed our weekend Mass schedule. We will celebrate public Masses at 5:00 p.m. on Saturday, and 9:30 a.m. & at 1:15 p.m. on Sunday. The 9:30 a.m. Sunday Mass will continue to be live streamed. The priests will hear confessions on Saturday in the Choir Room from 3:00 to 4:30 p.m.

Managing the weekend Masses will be more complicated. Under the guidelines, we can offer a maximum 25% capacity in the Church. People entering the Church will be required to wear a mask. If you do not have a mask we will turn you away. We will exercise social distancing and public safety precautions. Given the restrictions, we estimate that we will be able to seat 70 people in the Church. We will also utilize Johnson Hall in a similar way with Mass on-screen and Communion brought from the Church to the Hall. This will add seating for about 50 more persons. Parish collections will be taken under the form of you dropping your envelopes in a basket on the Offertory table.

Entry and exit from the church will be strictly regulated to comply with government and diocesan rules. Once we have reached capacity, the Church and Hall will be closed. Those arriving too late will be turned away with the assurance of the Bishop's dispensation from attendance. No standing will be allowed. There will be no gathering in the Narthex before or after Mass. Once Mass is over, we invite you to go to your car and depart immediately. Parts of the church and parish buildings that are not in active use will remain closed at all times. People will not be allowed to pray in the Day Chapel, there will be no rosary before daily Mass. The Adoration Chapel will remain closed. The Parish Offices will be closed to the public. All communications with the office will be conducted by email and phone.

We have not made a decision yet but we anticipate that Baptisms and First Communions will be celebrated in June. Weddings and Funerals will be celebrated with all the above restrictions and regulations.

Right now we are going to see how things go. If we are found to be safe we will gradually open up more. If we enter into danger we will close immediately.

On behalf of the priests and staff of the parish we wish you best wishes. Be healthy and safe.




