

From the Pastor's Office

Ascension of the Lord/Seventh Sunday of Easter

I have to preface my few words by saying that just because I am a priest doesn't mean that I understand everything there is about God. The world of God is full of mysterious things. I can't quite figure out Ascension. There is a moment a few weeks back when we were told that Jesus appeared to Mary Magdalene in the tomb. Naturally she was very excited to see Him, so much so that she moved close to give Jesus a hug. Jesus responded by saying to Mary, "do not cling to me because I have not yet ascended to my Father." That makes me wonder. Does that explain why Jesus seemed to be half human flesh and half spirit? He seemed to walk through walls. He disappeared and re-appeared again. Did Jesus live in some kind of middle earth place between our earthly existence and our heavenly existence? Not sure. Ascension to the Father seems to be a journey up. When someone asks where Heaven is we tend to say that it is up. I guess it makes sense to say Hell is in the other direction. Jesus was taken up in a cloud. I don't know what that means. I am afraid to try to understand because my head is full of science fiction and all those superheroes. Ascension in the context of the Bible marks the day when Jesus departed from his earthly existence altogether and returned to His spiritual existence in Heaven. I hate goodbyes. I get so emotional I want to cry. I remember when my Mother died, just for a second, I felt like I was orphaned. My inner child cried out for a second, "who is going to take care of us now?" The parent says goodbye to their child first day of school. Goodbye at summer camp. Goodbye on the first day at the college dorm. It is natural for a minute to wonder. I am now by myself. I hope I can take care of myself. I guess there is never the right time. Sometimes you just have to dive in ready or not and get cracking. That's kind of how I feel about Ascension. Peter is now properly focused to become the rock on which the Church will build. They are all properly orientated. Jesus assures them that He will always be with them if they need Him. It is time to go.



Liturgy

ABOUT THE SINGING...

As we begin again to celebrate Mass in church, there has been much planning and research by the staff, both here and at the Diocese. One aspect of public worship that has received much attention is that of singing. It is well-documented that singing greatly increases the volume of aerosol (vaporized moisture) exchanged between each person and the surrounding air, as well as the distance that airborne particles travel and how deeply they are breathed in by others. In the early days of the current pandemic, we suspended choral singing at St. Catherine of Siena for this very reason; elsewhere, failure to do so led to tragic results.

In recent days, prominent associations of vocal teachers and choral societies have urged that singing in close groups and in public spaces should be avoided and discouraged for the health and safety of all, until the pandemic is definitively ended. Many openly speak of this remaining necessary for one to two years. It is telling that these groups, whose primary focus lies in the promotion of singing, are taking this approach! Here in the Catholic Diocese of Austin, officials in the Bishop's offices have sent out similar instruction to the parishes. It is perhaps easiest to agree that singing while wearing a mask is cumbersome. It has also become necessary to remove our music books from the pews, which simply can't be properly sanitized between Masses. Finally and perhaps most importantly, we consider the health and well-being of our beloved cantors and psalmists. As noted, the deep and unmasked breathing required to accomplish this ministry places them at heightened risk in a public space. Given the current environment of uncertainty and the potential for outbreak, we cannot in good conscience expose them to the risk of illness or worse. Given these considerations. singing at Mass will remain on hold for the near term. As with all such important aspects of worship, we will continually revisit this, and will proceed only when we can do so in good conscience and with the benefit of scientific reassurance for the safety of the community and our volunteers. We hope that everyone in the parish will understand, and that we will all continue to praise God in song whenever the opportunity presents itself!

All members of liturgical ministries (including Mass Coordinators, Ushers and Hospitality, Lectors, Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion, Psalmists, Cantors, Musicians and Choir Members) over 18 years of age must remain in compliance with this Diocesan program as a required part of their service in the parish ministry. 


