

From the Pastor's Office

21st Sunday in Ordinary Time

The Gospel tells us that Jesus brought his apostles to the region of Caesarea Philippi. Often Jesus took them away with him. Those days were more like retreats away from the crowds. A time to reflect and talk. Caesarea Philippi was a scary place. This is not a place where you might go and have a picnic. The place had a big rock formation, big cliffs. There was a cave. People believed that this cave was one of the entrances to the Underworld. Scary. Worse than that, there also existed the shrine to the God Pan. Pan was not a very nice God. He is depicted as half-man/half-goat playing his flute. Pan loved to frighten people which only added to the mystery of Caesarea Philippi. Scattered about the place were many pagan temples to the gods. This was indeed a scary place, a sober place for a picnic.

We can tell from the conversation in the Gospel that it was time for some serious talk. All the time Jesus had His plan to go to Jerusalem. All the time it was important for Him to know that His Apostles were with Him no matter what happened. It was time for Jesus to find out what they really thought. "Who do people say that I am?" In the world of politics and elections you might write an opposition paper on your opponents. We all want to know what people think. The replies seem to be vague. "Some people say you are John the Baptist, others Elijah, still others Jeremiah or one of the prophets." We often hide our opinion behind what people say. Because I don't want to get into trouble I keep my cards close to my chest. We are about to enter the election of our next President. It is understandable if people keep their thoughts to themselves. True to character, Peter lets it all out. I guess Peter and I have something in common. Staff tell me that I don't have a filter. I say exactly what I think. Strange that people find honest communication to be something less. "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God." Peter gets Jesus. Whatever about his ramblings and overstepping the mark, Peter gets Jesus. He knows who He is. Maybe we can work with this. Jesus is so impressed that Peter is willing to say what he thinks. He doesn't hide behind what other people say. You say what you mean, and you mean what you say. If I don't say it, I don't know whether I am right or wrong. Jesus rewards Peter's truth and honesty. That is kind of the right thing to do. If I were to ask you who do you say Jesus is, the chances are that you will probably just repeat what Peter said. That is Peter's answer. What is yours?

Liturgy

PLEASE - ARRIVE EARLY TO MASS! In the last few weeks. more and more people have been arriving to Mass later and later - in one recent Mass, over a third of the congregation arrived after Mass had begun! This makes seating everyone in the limited available space more difficult and stressful for the few ushers who are presently serving. A rush of late arrivals compounds this. Being part of a last-minute rush may mean that you will not be able to find a seat in the church. Once all the spots in the church are filled, there is no standing allowed in the Narthex; it may be possible to open up additional seats in the Parish Hall, but a last-minute rush will also delay your entry there. Help us take care of everyone, and help ensure yourself a seat, by arriving early. And while at Mass, please follow the instructions of the Ushers at all times - especially during Communion and when the church is being vacated at the end of Mass.

EUCHARISTIC ADORATION WILL BE OFFERED IN THE MAIN CHURCH from 9:30 to 11:30 a.m., Monday through Friday. Church doors will open immediately before the Adoration hours begin. All who attend must observe social distancing at all times, using only the areas marked for seating in the church; congregating in the Narthex or other church areas will not be permitted during the ongoing pandemic. The Day Chapel will remain closed. These adoration hours will allow time for private prayer before our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament. Personal devotions (the Rosary, Divine Mercy, etc.) are to be prayed individually, maintaining silence for the sake of others who may wish to pray without interruption.

WE ARE GRATEFUL FOR YOUR HELP SANITIZING THE PEWS AFTER MASS ON WEEKDAYS AND WEEKENDS. We have upgraded the equipment, and a slightly different technique is required. Our aim is to thoroughly clean the pews without damaging them. If you would like to help, please wait in the Narthex after Mass for the usher team. Once the church is empty, they'll give you a quick tutorial. It takes just a few minutes, and the more of us who know how to do this properly, the better!

LITURGICAL MINISTERS! Do you know your EIM (Ethics and Integrity in Ministry) anniversary date? If you don't, please call Esther in the parish office at (512) 892-2420. All members of liturgical ministries (including Mass Coordinators, Ushers & Hospitality, Lectors, Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion, Psalmists, Cantors, Musicians and Choir Members) over 18 years of age must remain in compliance with this Diocesan program as a required part of their service in the parish ministry. During the current conditions, the Diocese is temporarily offering the renewal course online. Contact Esther or Jennifer in the parish office to find out more.






