**From the Pastor's Office**

*28th Sunday in Ordinary Time*

The King wanted to celebrate the wedding of his son with a grand banquet. That is something we would all love to be at. This would be a chance to buy some swell clothes and enjoy a grand evening with important people. Sad to say, those on the guest list were indifferent. In fact, the King sent his servants out two times and still they wouldn't come. Bit disappointing. Then the King, determined that this would be a success, sent his servants out again and basically invited anyone and everyone to come to the feast. Because of etiquette it mattered that people come dressed properly. Anyone who was not wearing proper wedding clothes were turned away. That's a thing. Properly we should dress up for special occasions. I have celebrated weddings where the guests arrived in their blue jeans and dirty boots. You can wear that on the farm, but not at a wedding. The King in this parable story must be God. He so yearns for us to come to the banquet that he sent out his servants a bunch of times to remind us. In ancient times before they had post and email, whenever there was a banquet or a special dinner, when everything was ready, the servants were dispatched to visit all the guests and tell them that "dinner is ready."

The first lesson from Isaiah talks about banquets as well, this time on the top of a mountain. I don't think I would find that much fun. The most extraordinary thing I ever did was celebrate Mass on the top of a mountain. I was on retreat. Two religious sisters invited me to climb the mountain with them. They suggested we celebrate Mass on the mountain. I trekked and I climbed. There we were on the summit, wind blowing celebrating the Eucharistic banquet. Not really my best hour. In the Bible any reference to "the mountain" or to "the heavenly Jerusalem" is a reference to Heaven. In the Heavenly place we will enjoy a banquet to celebrate that it is the Lord who provides for us. It is the Lord who will destroy death forever. It is the Lord who will wipe away our tears. On this mountain, behold our God.

**MASS SCHEDULE RESUMES:** Beginning this weekend, we will resume our entire regular Mass schedule: Saturday at 5:00 p.m., Sunday at 7:30 a.m., 9:30 a.m., 11:30 a.m., 1:15 p.m., & 5:00 p.m.

### ABOUT THE SEATING...

As the parish resumes its full regular Mass schedule, we are continuing to follow physical distancing protocols in the hopes of preventing any potential transmission of the coronavirus, for which there remains as yet no certain cure. Our ushers return to their customary teams, some for the first time since the shutdown. We are training them in how to help keep everyone safe and seat them to best effect, using all the available seats in the church and avoiding the need to send anyone to the Hall until it is truly necessary. Before we resumed the full schedule, we were regularly coming within just a few seats of the church's safe capacity, which is now just over 160. Although the return to six Masses from three has alleviated this to some extent, as more folks come back to Mass in person we must be prepared to face this scenario again. To that end, we are beginning the routine of seating the church from front-to-back as the assembly arrives, assigning seats on a first-come, first-served basis. Although this eliminates the option to select one's own seat, it is important to understand the role of an orderly seating process in helping accommodate all who gather. We are a Catholic Christian community, and to supply each other's need, we must be willing to offer up a bit of personal preference from time to time. Your understanding and cooperation with our Usher ministry is greatly appreciated! More than ever, we never know exactly who is going to arrive or when, even up to and after the beginning of Mass. As always, to help ensure yourself a seat within the church sanctuary, please arrive early for Mass.

**WE ARE CONTINUING TO SANITIZE THE PEWS AFTER MASS ON WEEKDAYS AND WEEKENDS.** The number of volunteers for this changes from day to day, and on some days there are few or no volunteers. To help us maintain this safeguard, please wait in the Narthex after Mass. Once the church is empty, sanitizing can begin. The more who participate, the less time it takes for those who do, and the more who know how to do this properly, the better!

**LITURGICAL MINISTERS!** Do you know your EIM (Ethics and Integrity in Ministry) anniversary date? If you don't, please call the parish office at (512) 892-2420. All members of liturgical ministries over 18 years of age must remain in compliance with this Diocesan program as a required part of their service in the parish ministry.
