

**From the Pastor's Office***First Sunday of Advent*

COVID-19 has ruined everything. Beginning the season of Advent, we are invited to enter into a reflective season before we celebrate Christmas. The spirit of this season is that we are looking forward with anticipation. I can't wait to express my joy at the coming of the Messiah. This year feels different. We don't know what we are going to do. Every day the news seems to get worse and worse. We are groaning for this vaccine. When will this endless toil stop. We need something to hang on to, something to hope for. The readings at Mass reflect our mood. "Oh, that you would rend the heavens and come down. Behold you are angry, and we are sinful; all of us have become like unclean people, we have all withered like leaves. You have hidden your face from us. You are the potter, we are the clay." I guess we are learning our lesson the hard way. No, we are not in charge. Never were. We have been living in a slow despair. So many disappointments. So many of our Thanksgiving and Christmas plans have been washed away. We are now the people who walk in darkness. We always thought that happened to ancient biblical people. We never thought that would be us today. Paul says in one of his letters that we should grieve like people who have hope. That matters. As bad as things are or might become, we must always cling to hope. Christmas comes close to us and we are invited to look forward to it. The dark winter has taken its toll on us. We have to hang in there. Relief will come. The thing is we have to be patient. That is something we love to tell other people. Now we have to say it to ourselves. Everything takes time. As bad as COVID-19 is, it forces us to think about the things that actually matter. What is the meaning of my life? What are the things that actually matter to me? What meaning does Christmas have for me? I don't mean it is time to spend with family and friends. I mean, do I appreciate that I have a Savior who comes to save me. Maybe I need some saving right now. Maybe I am not doing great because of my despair. I have to hang in there. Dory's advice in "Finding Nemo" is as good as any I have heard, "Just keep swimming, keep on swimming, swimming, swimming, just keep swimming..."
