

From the Pastor's Office

Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Moses represents the Word of the Lord spoken way back when. The time of Moses is a long time ago, but, God spoke in his time. Through the mouth of Moses, God said, "A prophet like me will the Lord, your God, raise up for you from among your own kin; to him you shall listen." For the rest of our times we go in search of this prophet. Who is this one that God sent into our midst? We are still searching for this voice today. We testify that we have found this voice in the Lord Jesus from Nazareth. Lots of people today don't know that or they are not ready to settle. Lots of people are searching for meaning in this world and they can't find it. It is hard to recognize and see the Lord, but when we have found Him we are delighted. When we find the Lord, we make a connection. We are no longer sheep wandering among the fields. We don't feel lost anymore. We have found the Lord. If only our children, members of our family could experience the joy that we feel. When hard times come we feel like we have someone to go to for refuge. This Messiah walked into the synagogue at Capernaum. It was all a bit spectacular. The first thing they noted about this stranger was that He spoke with authority. For some people that is very important. Have something to say and say it well. Then we had the episode of the man with the unclean spirit. When something unexpected happens you kind of hope it happens at the side. You don't want to make a fool of yourself in the public glare. But life is like that. This is happening now. I have to deal with this now with all these people watching. Jesus is masterful. He is completely in charge. He drives the spirit out of the man and everybody was amazed. You would think that things would get better after that. But there is always someone in the crowd who wants to throw a wrench into the works. Not everybody is with you. Not everybody is impressed by you. Every one of us has to find a way of dealing with this. But that is the nature of living. We journey through life. Good things and bad things happen, and we have to deal with them. You did good. You didn't do so good. On to the next thing. That is life. We know from other gospel sources that eventually the people of the synagogue turned against Jesus. But for now, things are going well. Thanks be to God.

THIS WEEK'S AT HOME PRESCHOOL THEME:

"HOMES." Shelter is one of our basic necessities and having a proper home contributes to our overall ' well-being. Our house keeps us safe. It provides us with a place to sleep and gather with our family. Inspire your child to work on their observation and comparison skills by thinking about how their house compares to other houses they have visited. Animals also need shelter where they have access to food, water, and protection from the harsh weather. Animals tend to live in places where they can get the items they need. For example, frogs live in places where land and water are available and panda bears live where they can find bamboo. Has your child seen any birds, butterflies, lizards, snakes, toads or spiders roaming around your yard or in the park? What do they think attracts these critters? Is there a way to attract more of them or discourage their presence? By encouraging curiosity and helping your child look for answers, you will increase the chances that they will become a life-long learner! Please bring your candles that day in a shopping bag or other portable container and keep them next to you when you sit in the pews. The blessing will be given during Mass.

MEMORIAL OF SAINT BLAISE AND BLESSING OF THE THROATS – WED., FEB. 3: Legend tells us that St. Blaise cured a young boy choking on a fish bone. We ask for St. Blaise's intercession of healing or keeping us free from any illness or injury to our throats. 


