

Implicit in all our preaching in Church is the call to discipleship. We are asked to respond to the call of Jesus. We do that in all kinds of ways. Some of us will respond to the call of Jesus by being faithful husbands and wives, good family people. Others will get active in the parish working in ministries, charity work, and service to the community. More will respond to the call of Jesus and consider ministry as priests and nuns. In the gospel today, Jesus called His disciples to go out in twos to do the work of God by spreading the gospel. In the first reading, we are given Amos who went out to do God's work. Amos is interesting because he does not fit the mold of what a minister of God should look like. As a mountain shepherd he is perfect. As a minister of the gospel he stands out as odd. Amaziah, the priest of Bethel rejects Amos as unfit for his role. Probably because Amos is a plain-speaking man. He doesn't disguise his message. This is it. Amaziah has spent too much time in his lofty robes. He is unable to hear the message of Amos because he is distracted by the look of Amos. Amos does not fit the profile of someone who might actually preach the message of God. We are all prejudiced in our own way. A person presents as well dressed, good appearance, well spoken, and people say, "He would make a lovely priest." The other person with the shoddy clothes, bit disheveled, not well spoken, and we conclude, definitely not a candidate for ministry. I remember how proud I felt about my Order when one of the candidates for priesthood was a dwarf. He was four foot something. He was a delightful man. He told us that he longed to study for priesthood, but nobody gave him a chance. What a lovely thing that he found welcome in our midst. I guess it takes all kinds. Jesus calls all of us to do His work. He is very happy to call mountainy men and women to His service. Shame on us when we are blinkered by our own prejudices and fanciful ideas as to who is suitable. Amos proved to be very effective. He didn't mince his words. Good on him. What was it Jesus said, that we judge people by their appearances and God judges by the heart. Absolutely right.

IMPORTANT MESSAGE FROM FR. PAT

* Opening Update and Vaccine Requirement *

We are pleased to announce that we will be opening the campus for group meetings effective August 2, 2021. A letter has been sent to each ministry group leader advising of this development. This letter states that each ministry group leader is responsible for the safety of all meeting attendees. As is the policy in the Church, we have asked that all ministry group leaders advise those attending that persons who are vaccinated are free to attend without a mask but those who are not are strongly encouraged to wear a mask covering both nose and mouth. As with the Church, the safety of everyone in attendance at the meeting is the responsibility of everyone. While there has been no size limitations imposed on any group, for the time being, we want everyone to know that we will not allow large social gatherings such as coffee and donuts, receptions and parties. We will reevaluate this limitation once the threat of the delta variant and other COVID issues have been resolved.

We announced a few weeks ago that we will require that all persons engaged in ministry, including catechists at every level, and general volunteers must be vaccinated to serve. This limitation was imposed to protect the vulnerable members of our community from exposure to COVID as a consequence of engaging with unvaccinated individuals who may be infected. This is wholly a public safety measure. We do not know how long this limitation will be in force but we will advise promptly once it can be lifted.
