#### From the Pastor's Office

22nd Sunday in Ordinary Time

The Pharisees drive me mad. I am sure they are fine people but if I am going out to eat I don't appreciate Pharisees planted at the next table taking notes about my eating habits. I am sure that everyone one time or another has sat down to eat without washing their hands. Can't be perfect all the time. I assure you when we were children and we were starved to death from the hunger, we did not dwell too long on the activity of washing our hands. We didn't wait too long for grace either. In the context of the Pharisees, they were referring to ritual cleaning. The devout Jew washed himself all the time. It is an outward expression that he is ritually clean before God. Fair enough, but do they have to harp on about it all the time? It is people like the Pharisees who drive people away from the Church. Jesus comes at them swift and hard. "This people honors me with their lips, but their hearts are far from me." We don't like people who pay lip service. They preach one thing but they live by another thing. "In vain do they worship me." I remember some comedy from my childhood where the man condemned the gossipy woman by accusing her of putting on her Christian face for Church and then filling her mouth with prayers. This mean woman had no problem denigrating her neighbors but in front of Father she was all goodness and light. What a lovely devout woman, not! If only other people were like her. No thank you! Jesus is very precise with his scalpel here. That which defiles a person does not come from without. It comes from within, from their hearts, from their evil thoughts. Ain't that the truth. I know people who have spread malice in the community. They know it is all lies but they hold onto their testimony. I know people who love gossip. What they don't know, they just make the rest up. They don't care if it is true or not. They are dying to believe it all the same. It's amazing how wicked some people get. These are the people that Jesus is talking about. They have nothing better to do than to dismantle people and their good name. That which defiles a person comes from within, from their hearts, from their evil thoughts.




