From the Pastor's Office

23rd Sunday in Ordinary Time

"Say to those whose hearts are frightened, be strong, fear not. Here is your God, He comes with vindication." From our earliest years as children, any time we were afraid we called out for Mommy or Daddy to come and make us feel safe again. That primitive expression remains with us all our lives. Before God we cry out to Him to bring us comfort. It is comforting to hear the voice of God say, I hear you, I come to you. The poor man of the Gospel reading suffered with a speech impediment. All of his life he cried out to God to come and heal him. I love the way Jesus took him aside so that He could minister to the man in a more intimate way. Jesus was very precise in what He did. He put His finger in the man's ears. He touched the man's tongue with His spittle. "Ephphatha, be opened." The little ritual of Jesus with this man is repeated today with our RCIA candidates. On Easter Saturday morning just before they are made full members of the Church, the priest blesses them on the ears and on the mouth with the holy oils and he repeats these words of Jesus, "Ephphatha, be opened." The idea is that we must open our ears to hear God's word. We must open our mouth to proclaim God's word. I always love the intimate moments when Jesus spends time with marginalized people. For example, the way He spent time with the Samaritan woman. The way He spent time with Jairus and his family, the way He spent time with Mary Magdalene, with the Gerasene demoniac. We all long for our intimate moment with Jesus. All those people who spend time in Adoration will testify that it is such an intimate experience to be there. Just me and Jesus. So often I meet Jesus and I am swallowed up in the midst of a crowd. Jesus is far away from me. I treasure those moments when we are together alone and I can really talk with Him. When I listen I can hear Jesus talk back to me. The frightened child of my past is comforted again. I am not alone. I am not forgotten. I think of the Paul Newman movie which captures the idea, "Somebody up there likes me."

SVdP members (over 1300 in the Austin Diocese) visit families providing emergency food, rent, helping keep the lights on, and other life needs. Over \$3.8 million in direct financial assistance served over 72,000 people in the last fiscal year. Our Austin Council distributes food and groceries weekly, provides bus passes, operates a Thrift Store, provides clothing and household goods vouchers and much more. It helps manage the distribution of pandemic relief funds for Travis County and City of Austin. All SVdP services provide individuals and families with assistance regardless of religion, race, or national origin.




