From the Pastor's Office

Second Sunday of Easter Divine Mercy Sunday

Sr. Faustina Kowalska, a Polish nun, reported visions and visitations from Jesus and had conversations with Him. He asked her to paint the vision of His merciful divinity being poured from His Sacred Heart and specifically asked for a feast of Divine Mercy to be established on the first Sunday after Easter Sunday so that humankind would take refuge in Him. The devotion to the Divine Mercy was promoted by Pope John Paul II. Pope John Paul speaking about the Divine Mercy said this, "Jesus said to St. Faustina one day: "Humanity will never find peace until it turns with trust to Divine Mercy. This is the Easter gift that the Church receives from the risen Christ and offers to humanity." The devotion to Divine Mercy, after the imprimatur of the Pope is now widely celebrated by Catholics. The image of the Divine Mercy is placed in the Church and people are invited to venerate.

On June 2002, Pope John Paul II granted indulgences to Catholics who recite specific prayers on this feast day. This afternoon devotions to the Divine Mercy will be prayed in our Church. You are welcome to join us.

Very quickly after the Resurrection of Easter, the early Church blossomed into a whole. Many came to believe in the message of Jesus. Many joined this new Church. The Christian Church was radically different from anything they had ever known. The believers were invited to have a personal relationship with the Lord Jesus. This was not some institutional worship on behalf of the Emperor. This was not worship of the Gods. This was personal. Early Christians loved to gather together. They sang their songs. They celebrated their sacred meal. They reached out to members of the community who were marginalized, poor, and struggling, and took care of them. The power of the Spirit was huge in their midst. This was the most dangerous



time of the early Church. The Pharisees and the Sanhedrin were actively looking to hunt down those Apostles of the Church. They were public enemy #1 in Israel. However, filled with the Spirit nothing could deter the Apostles. Their mission was clear, and it was time to get to work. The Lord Jesus was with them.




